

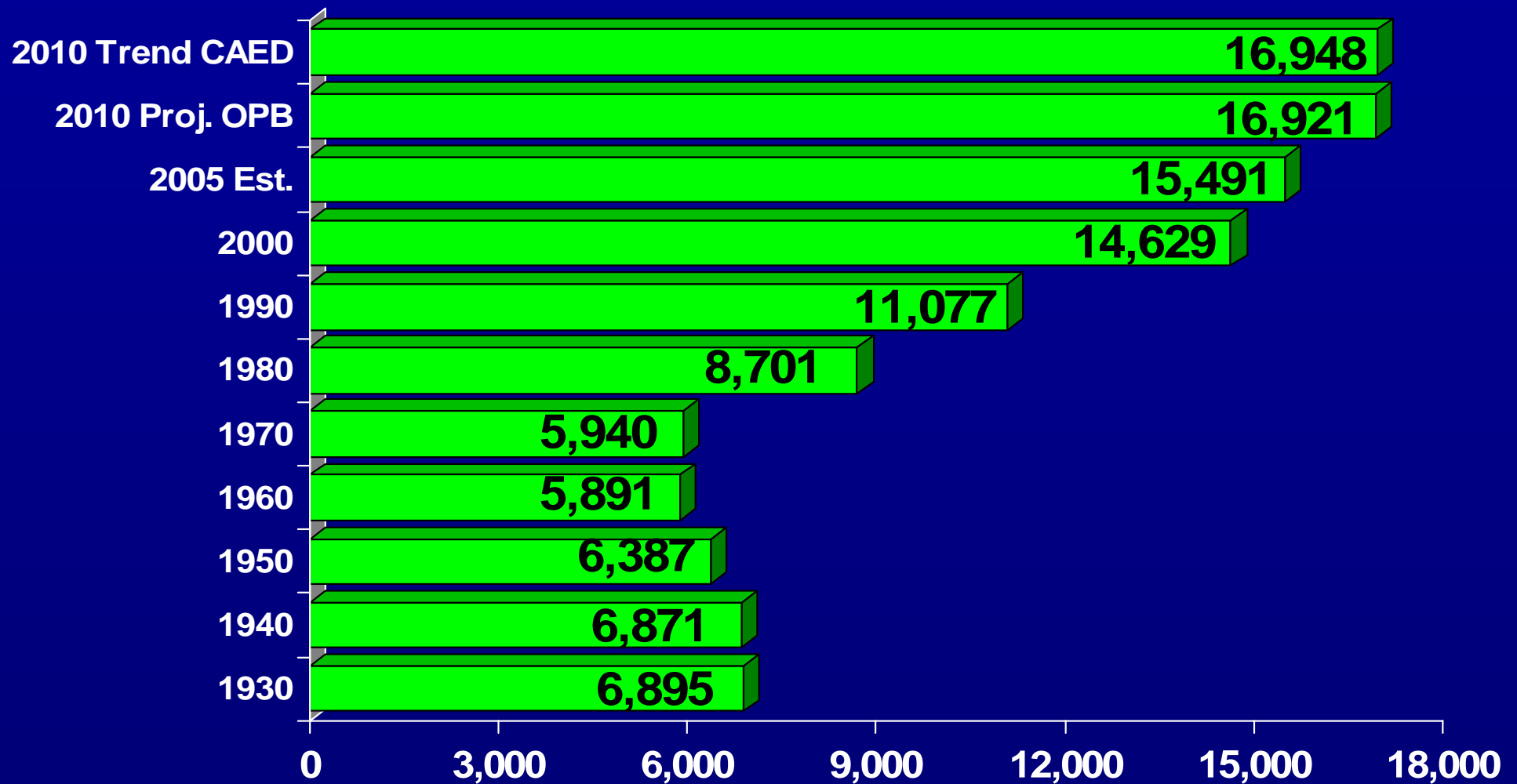

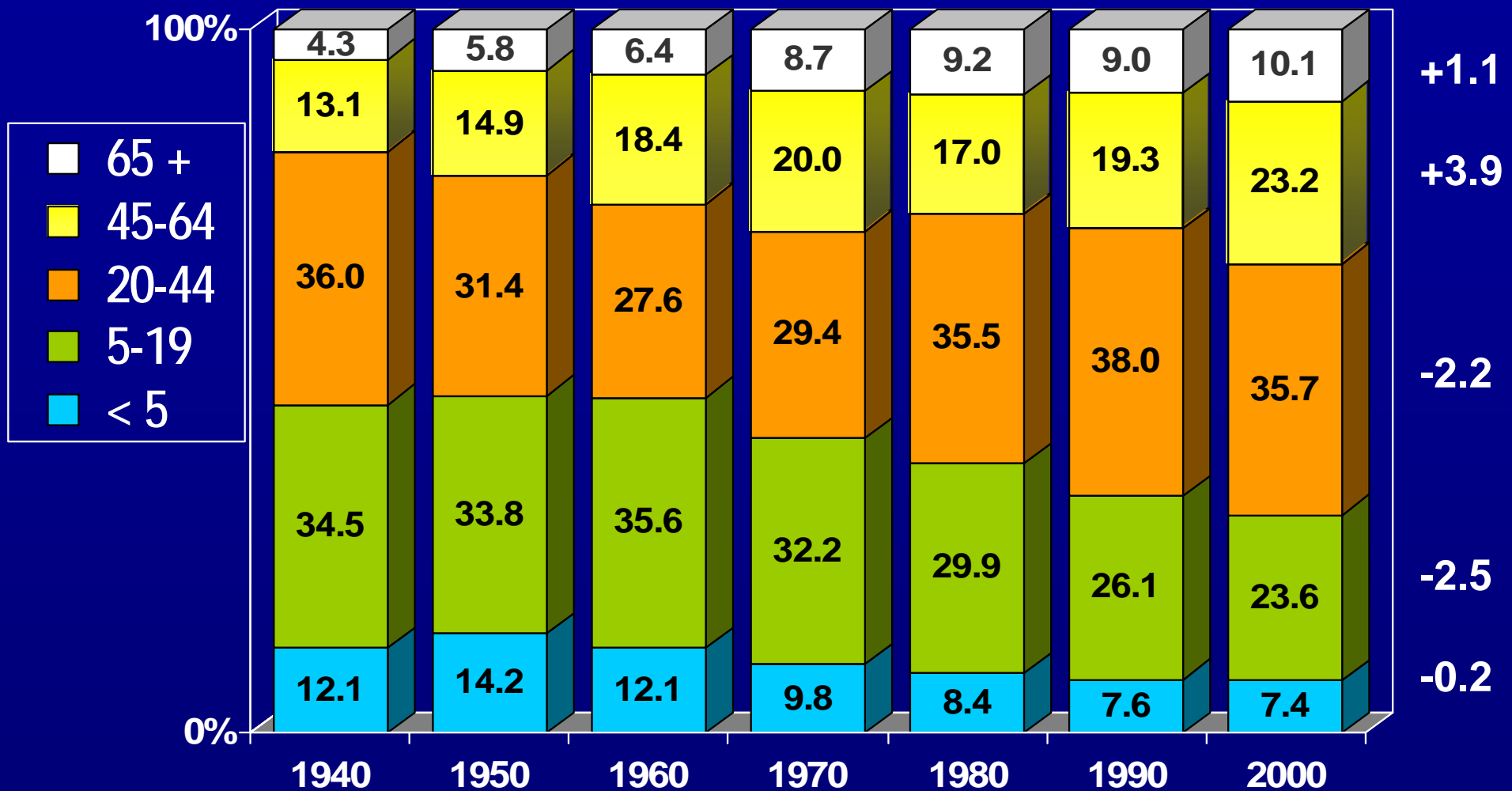
Total Population Brantley County

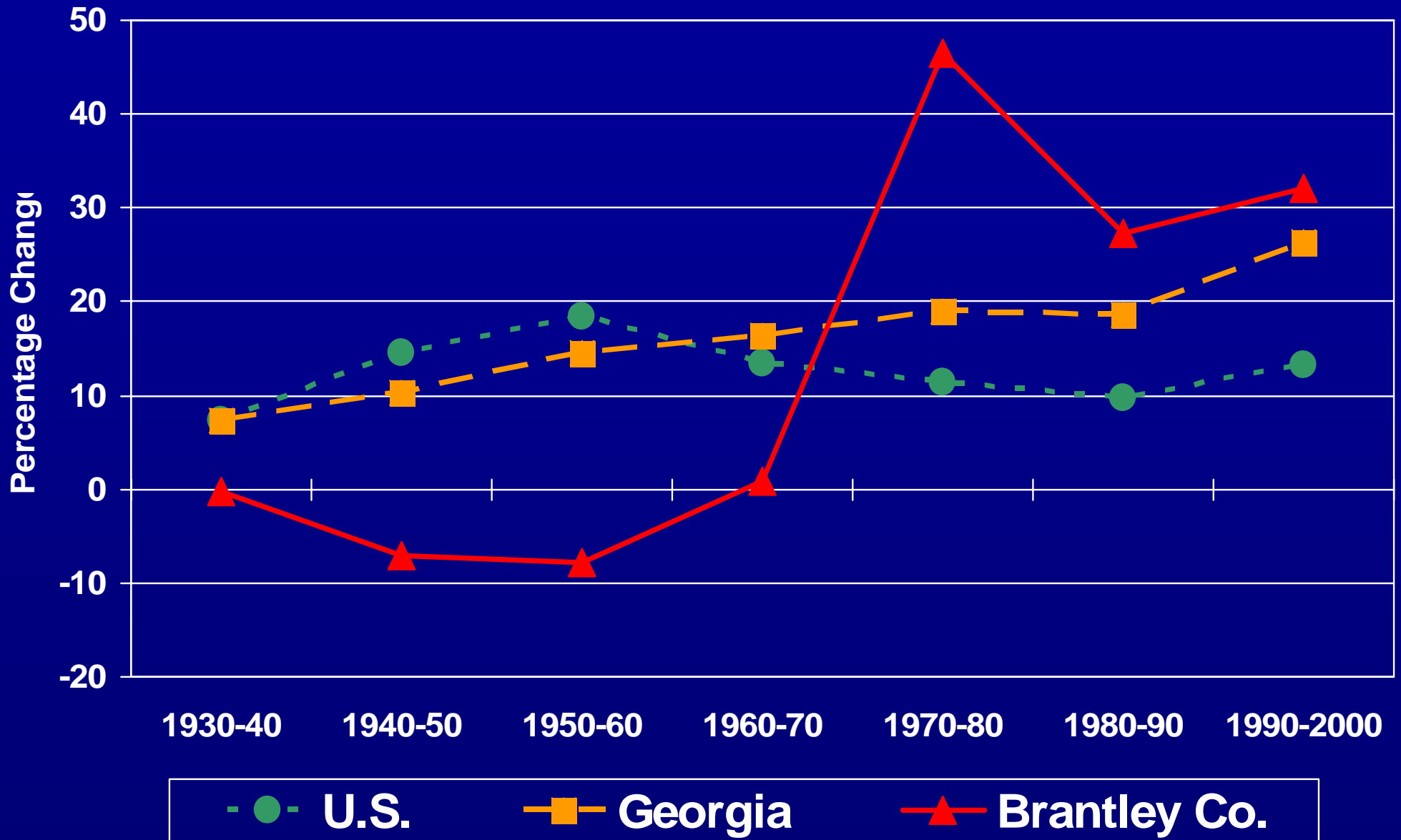

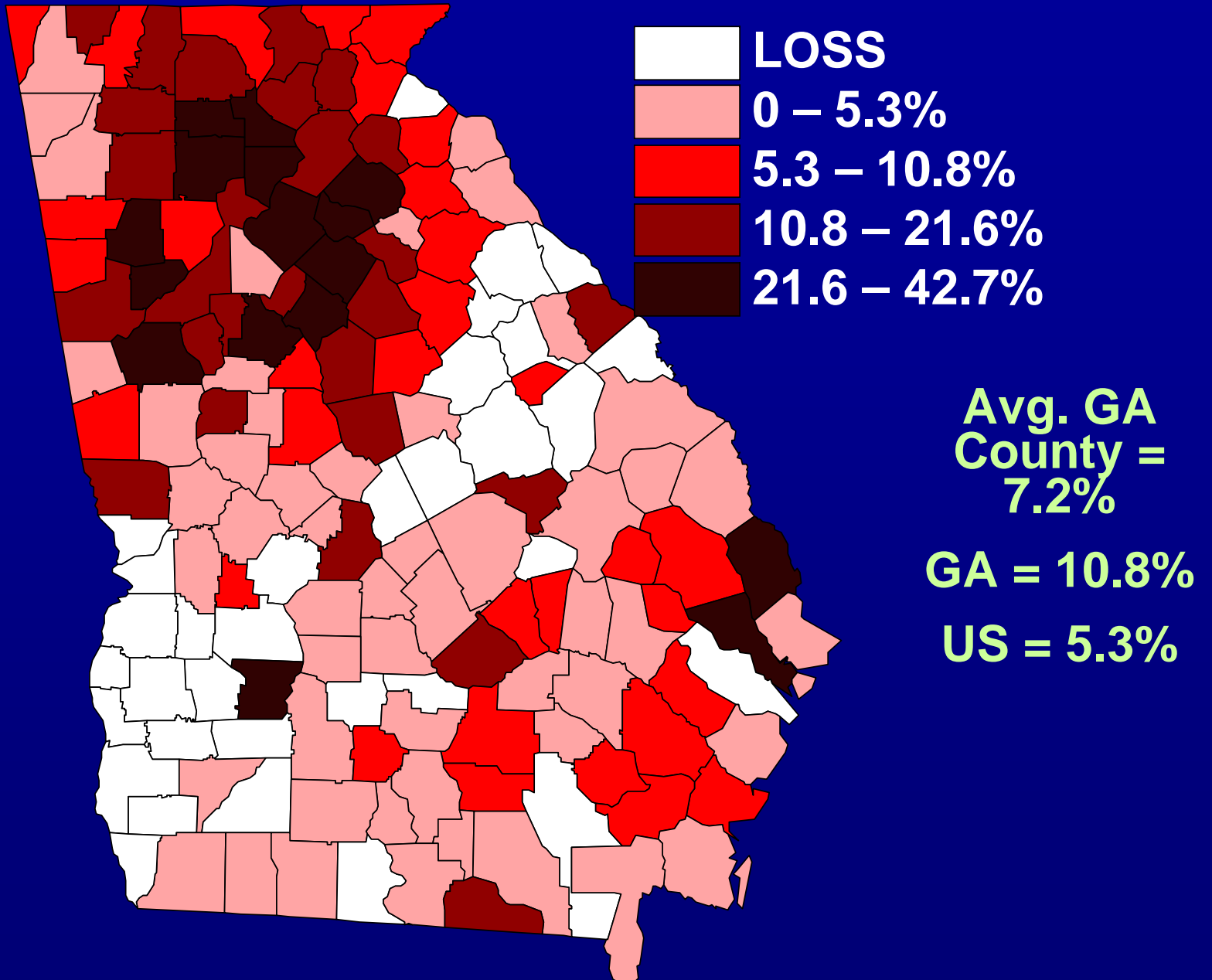

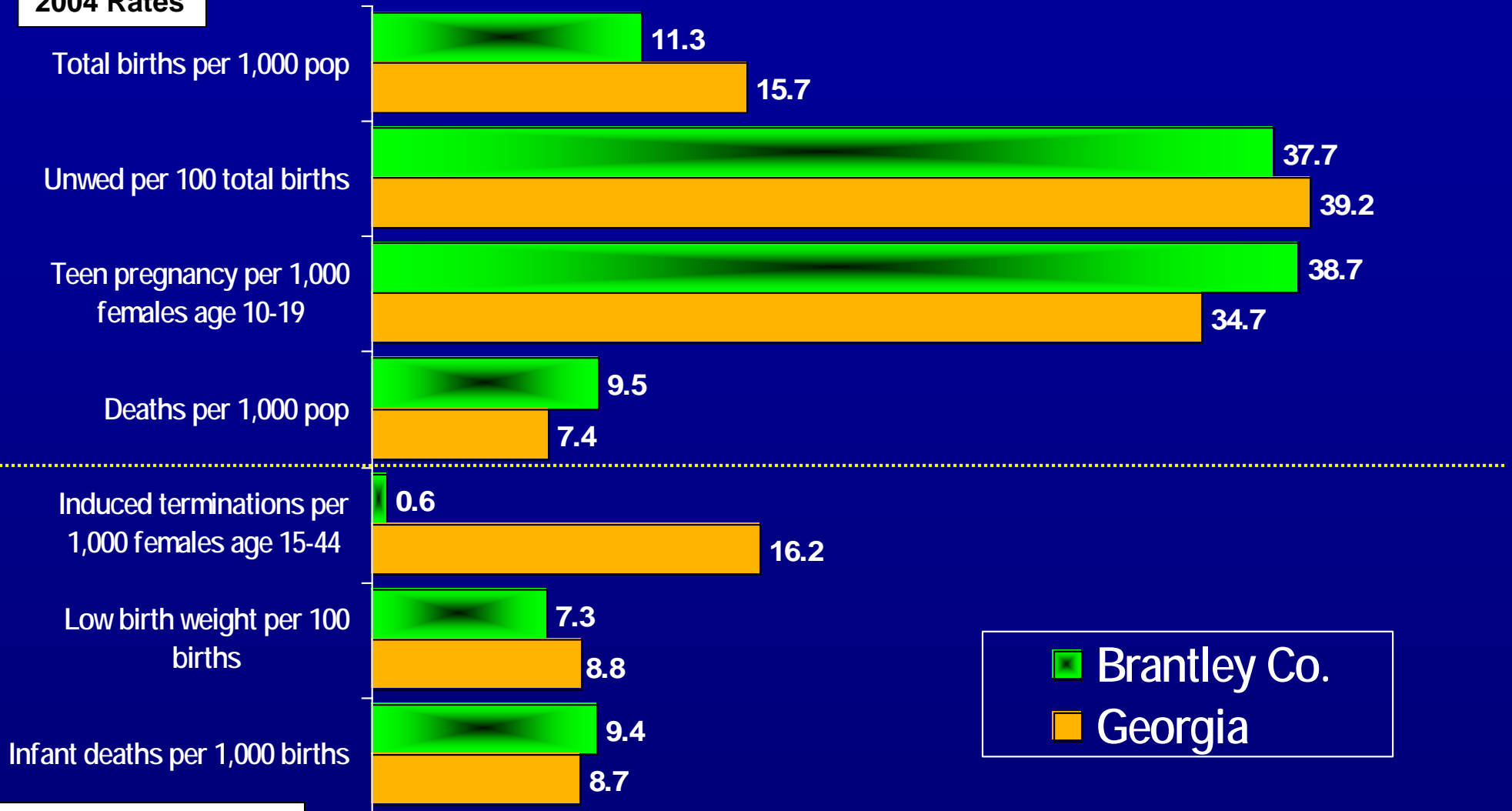

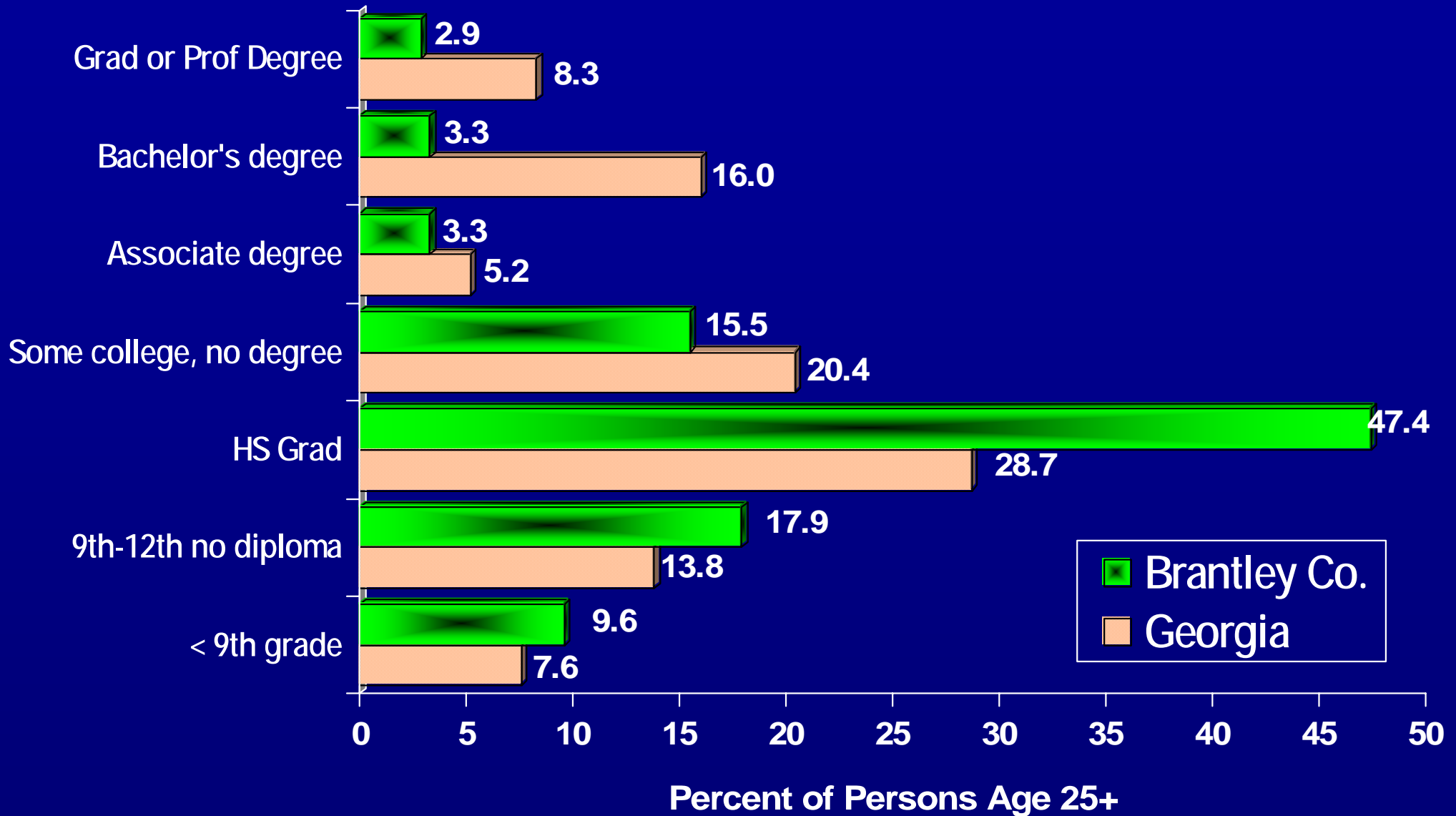

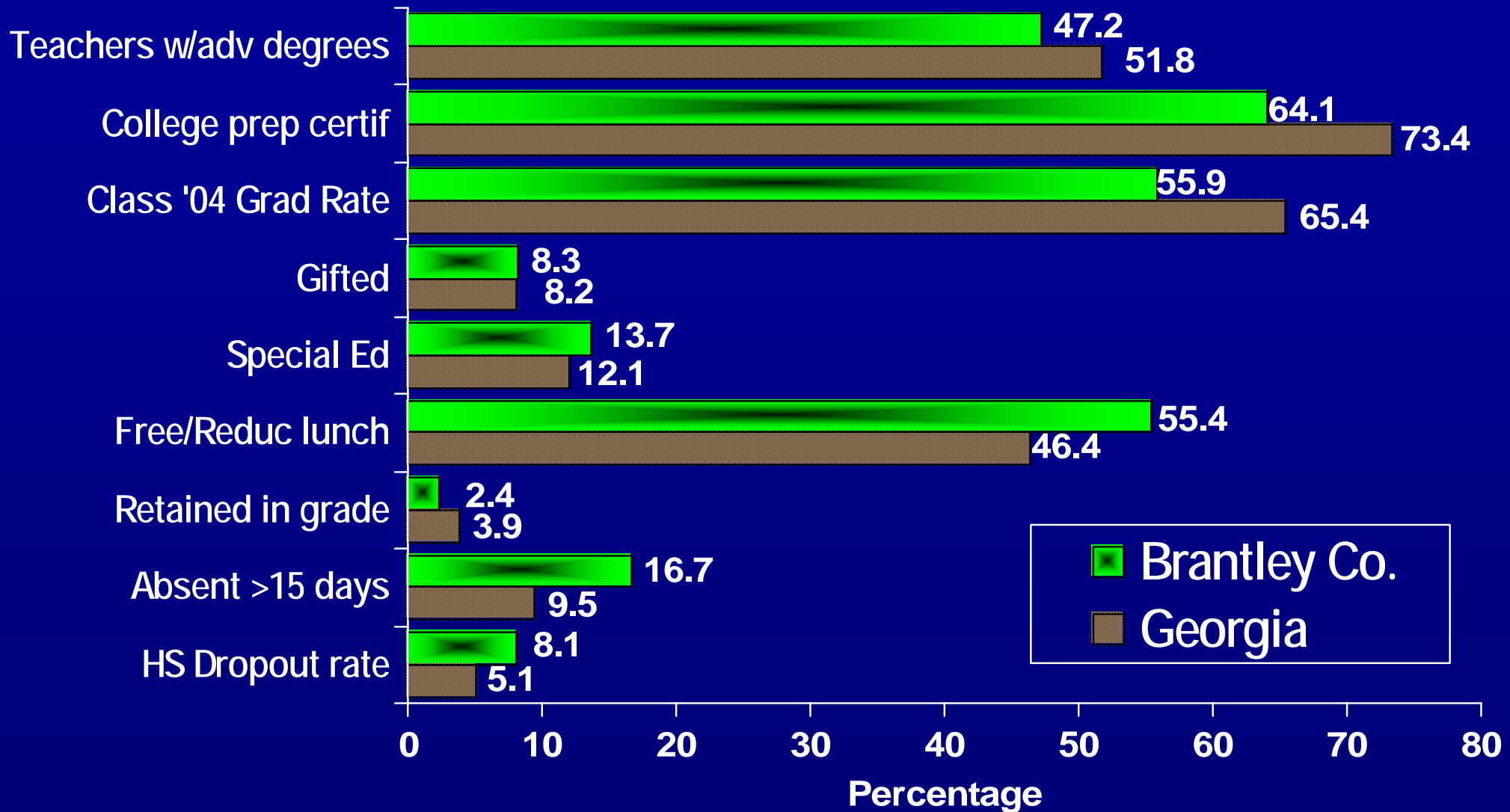

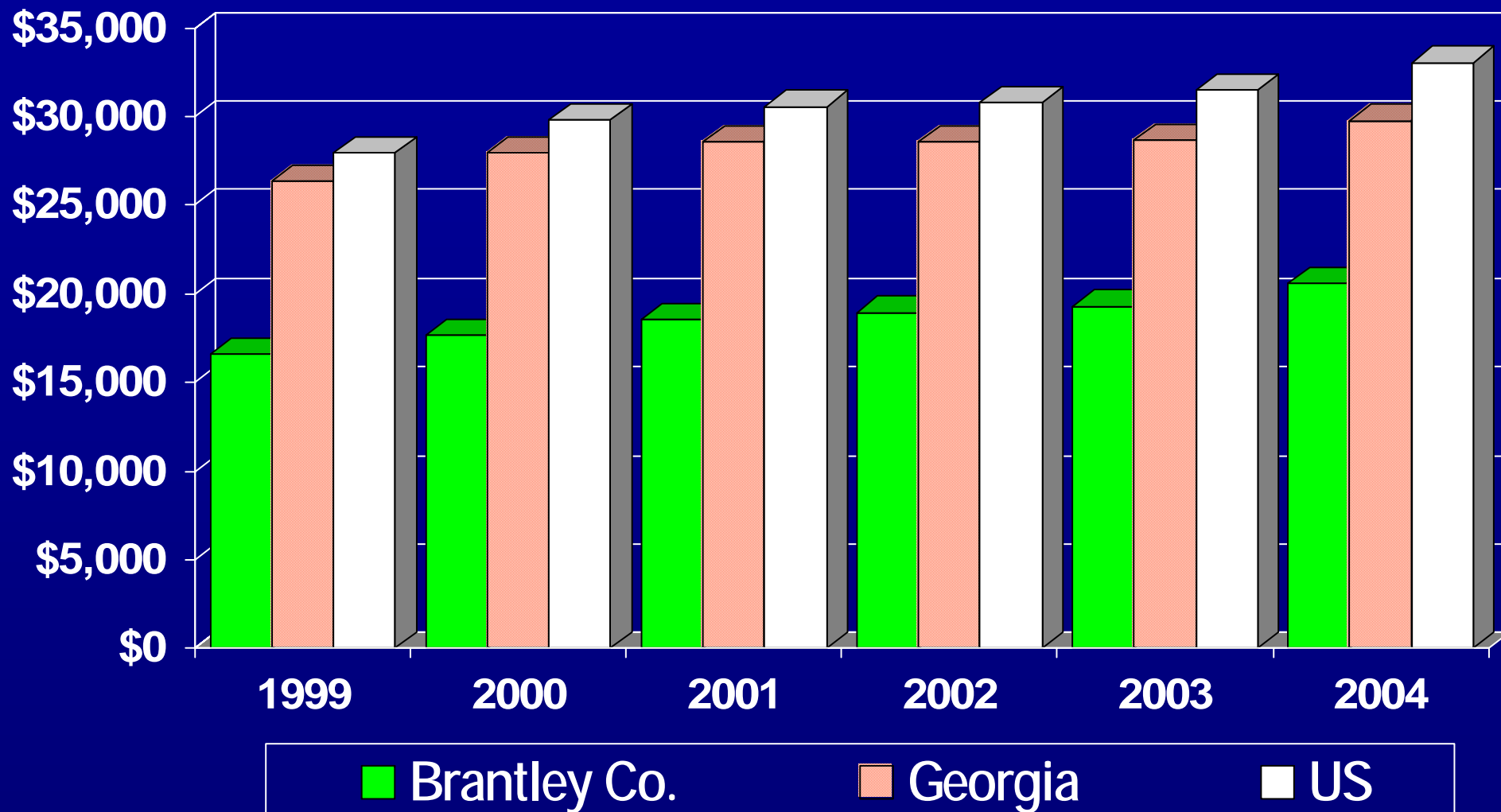

Per Capita Income: 1999-2004

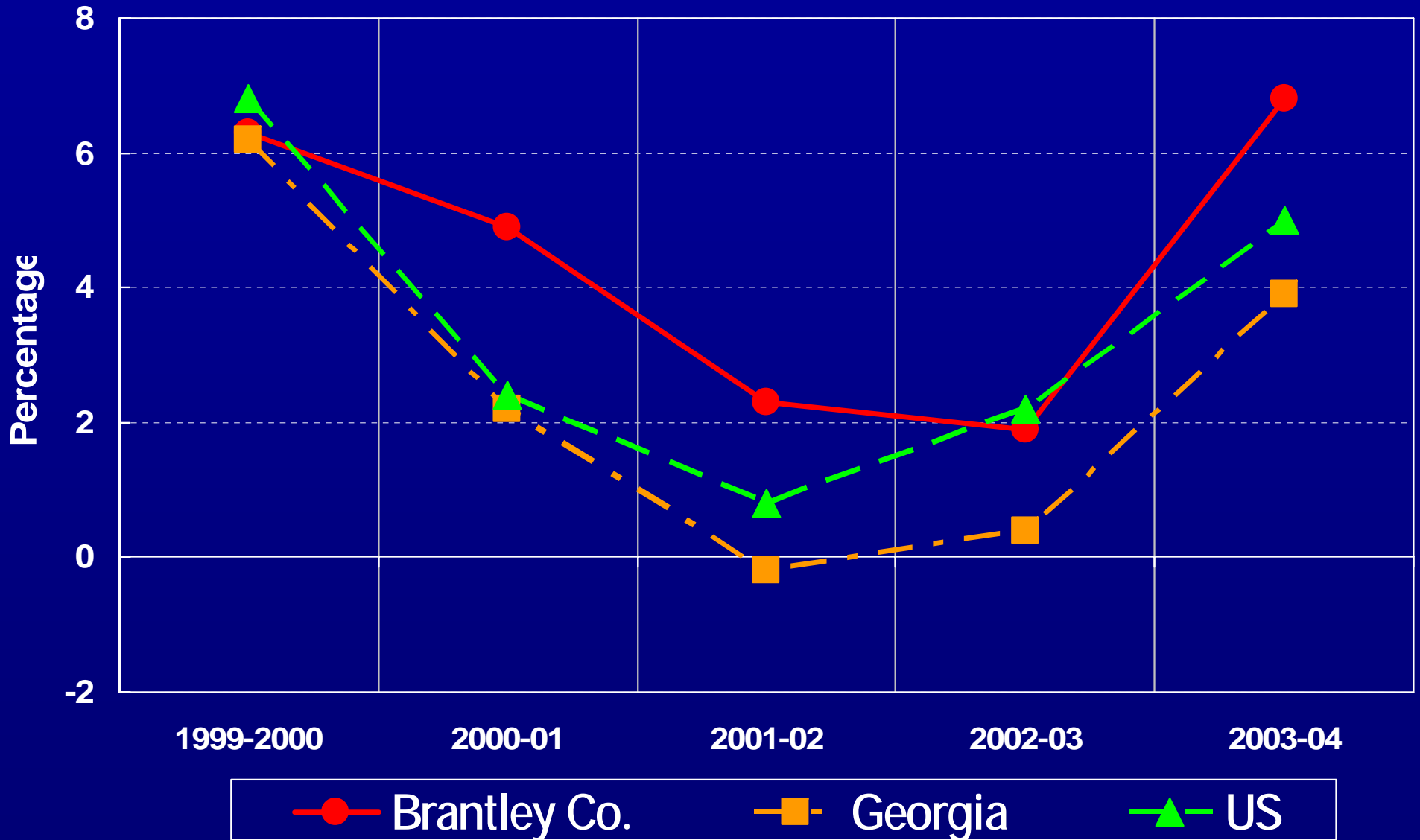

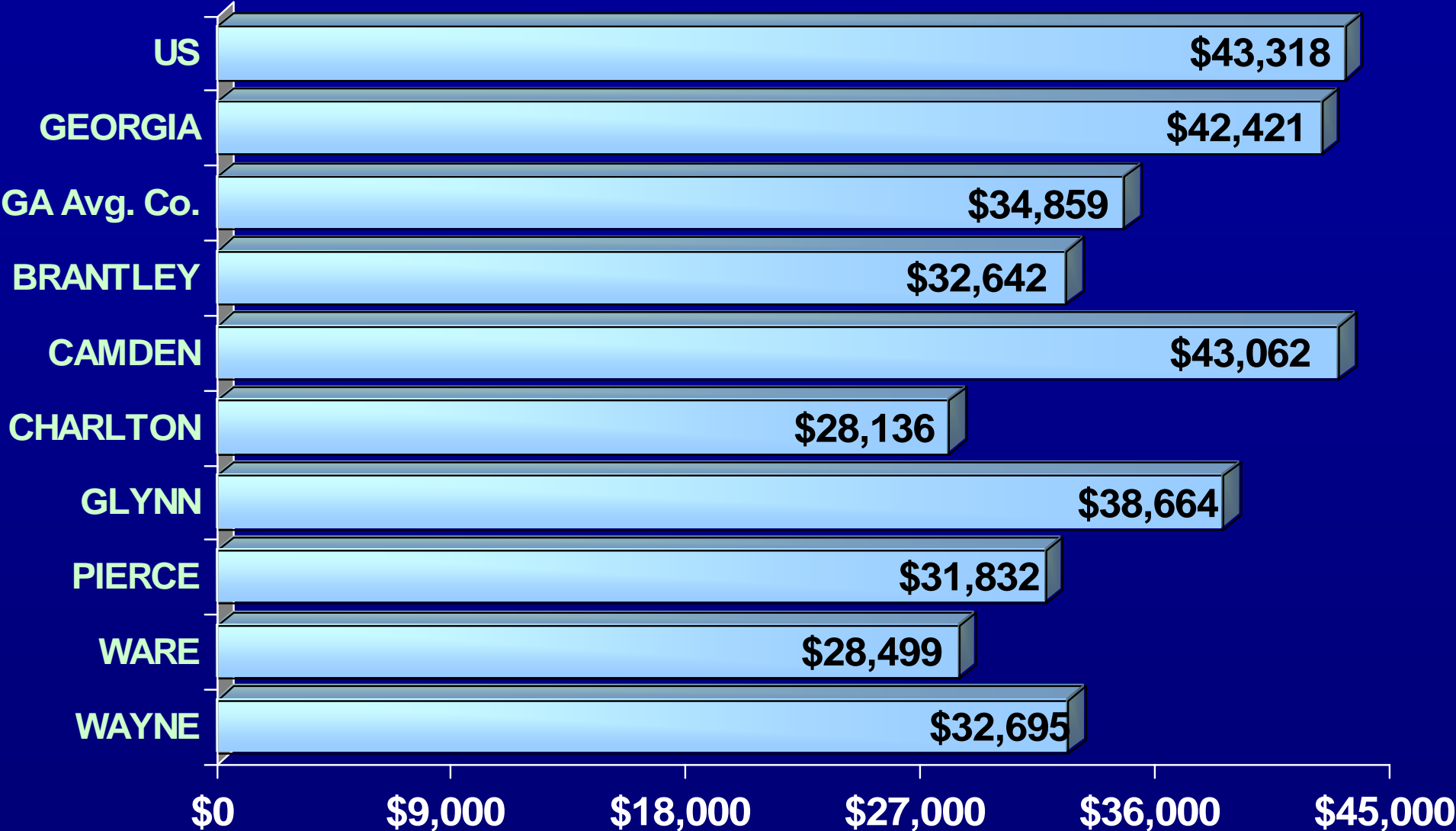

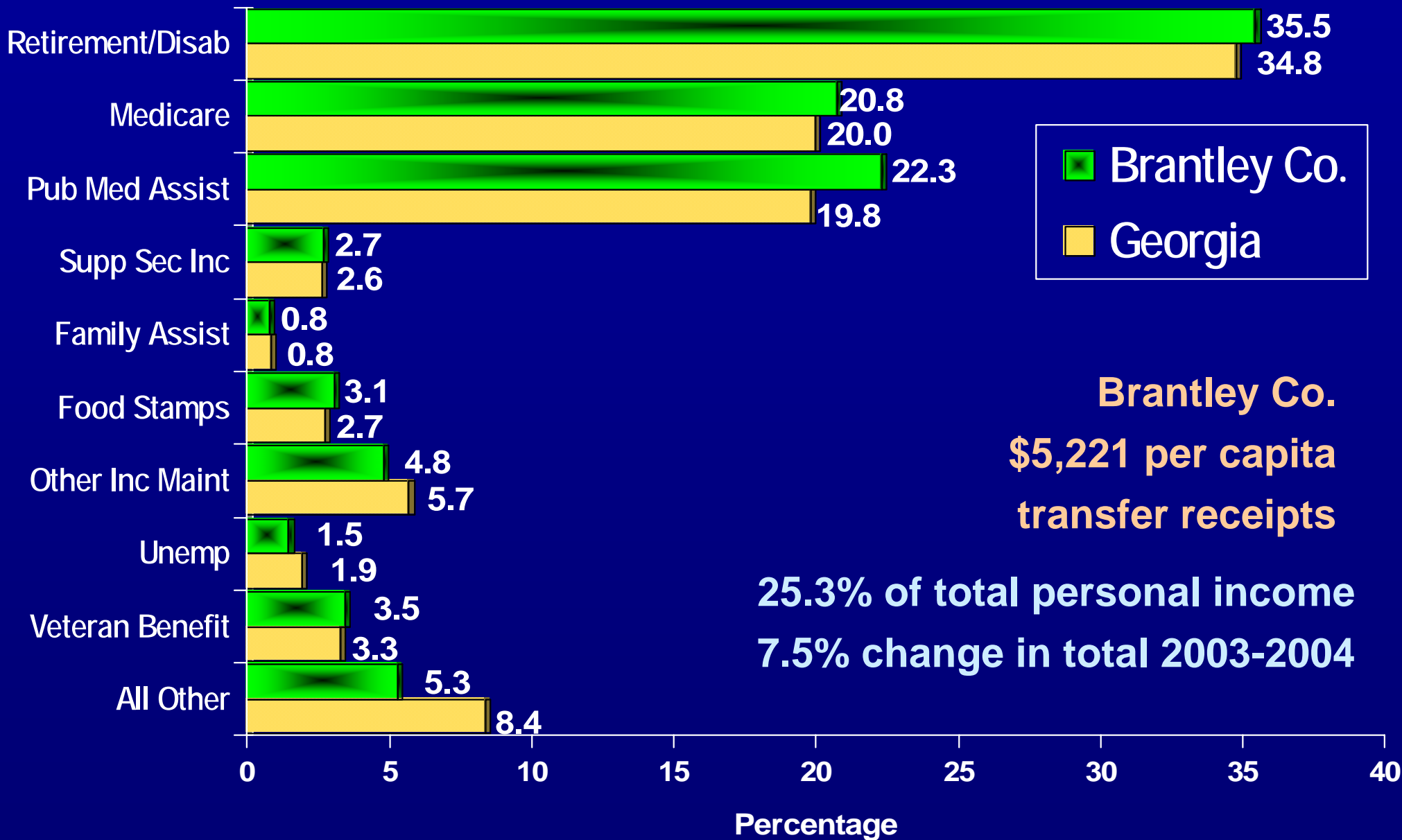

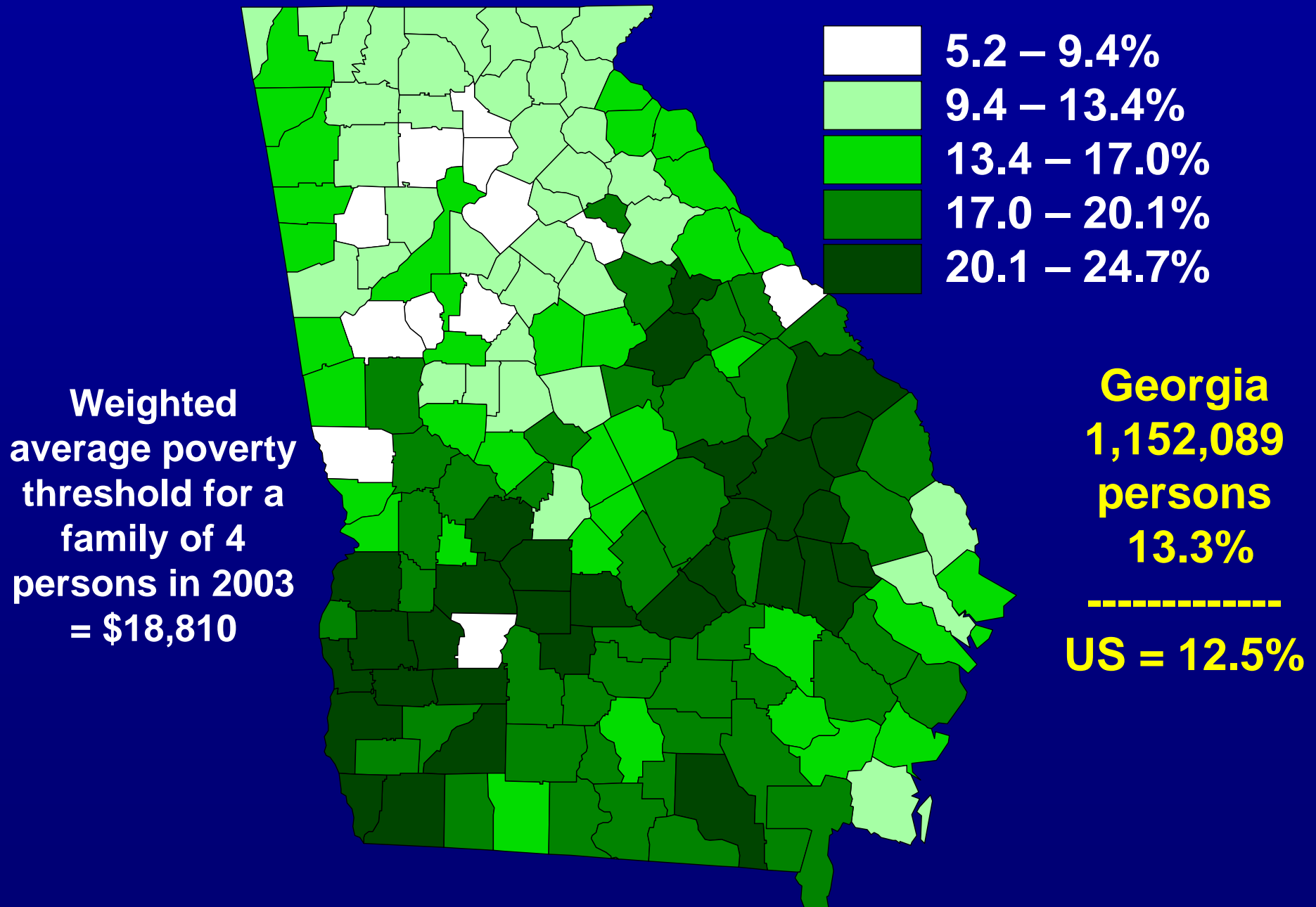

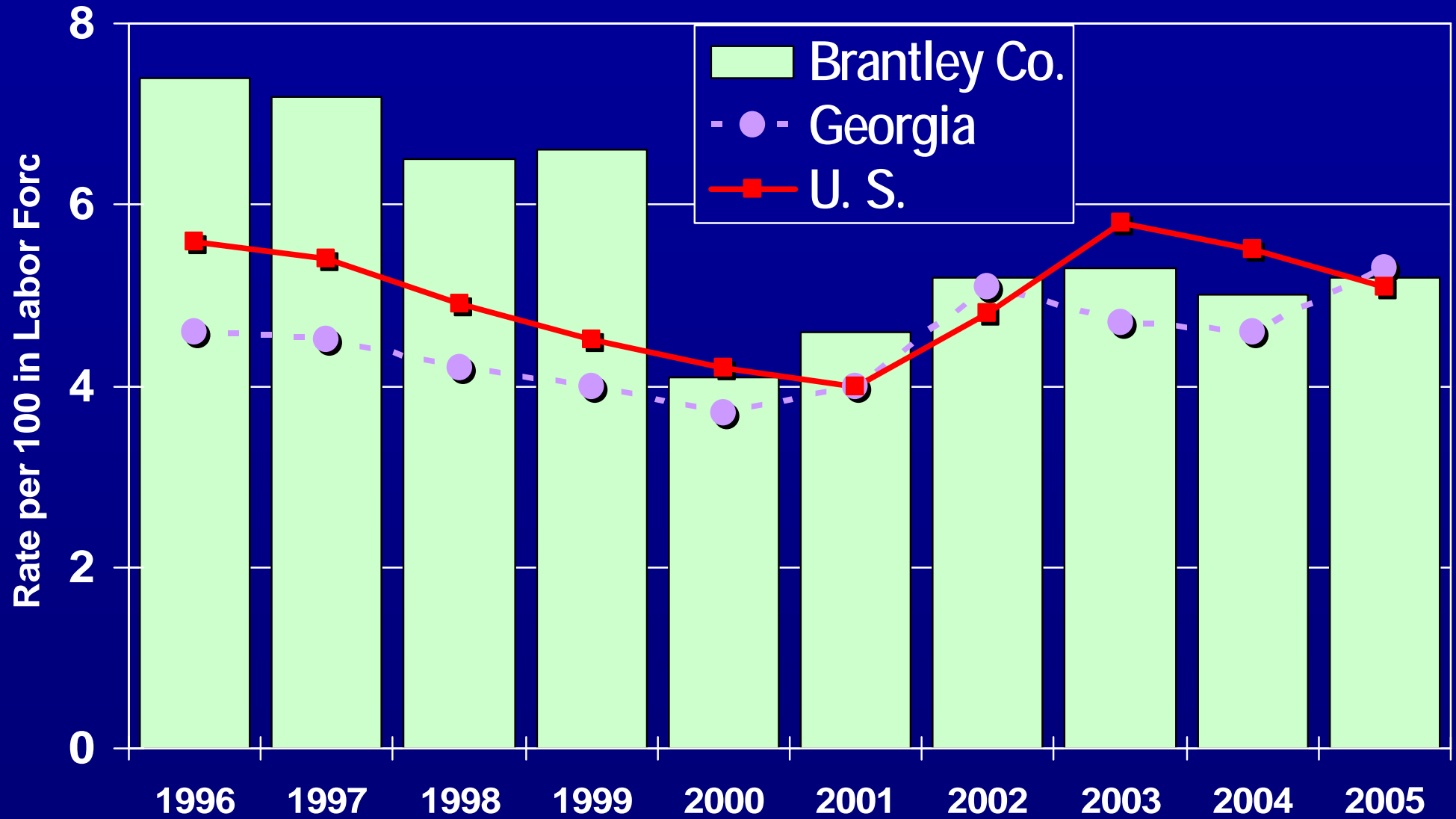

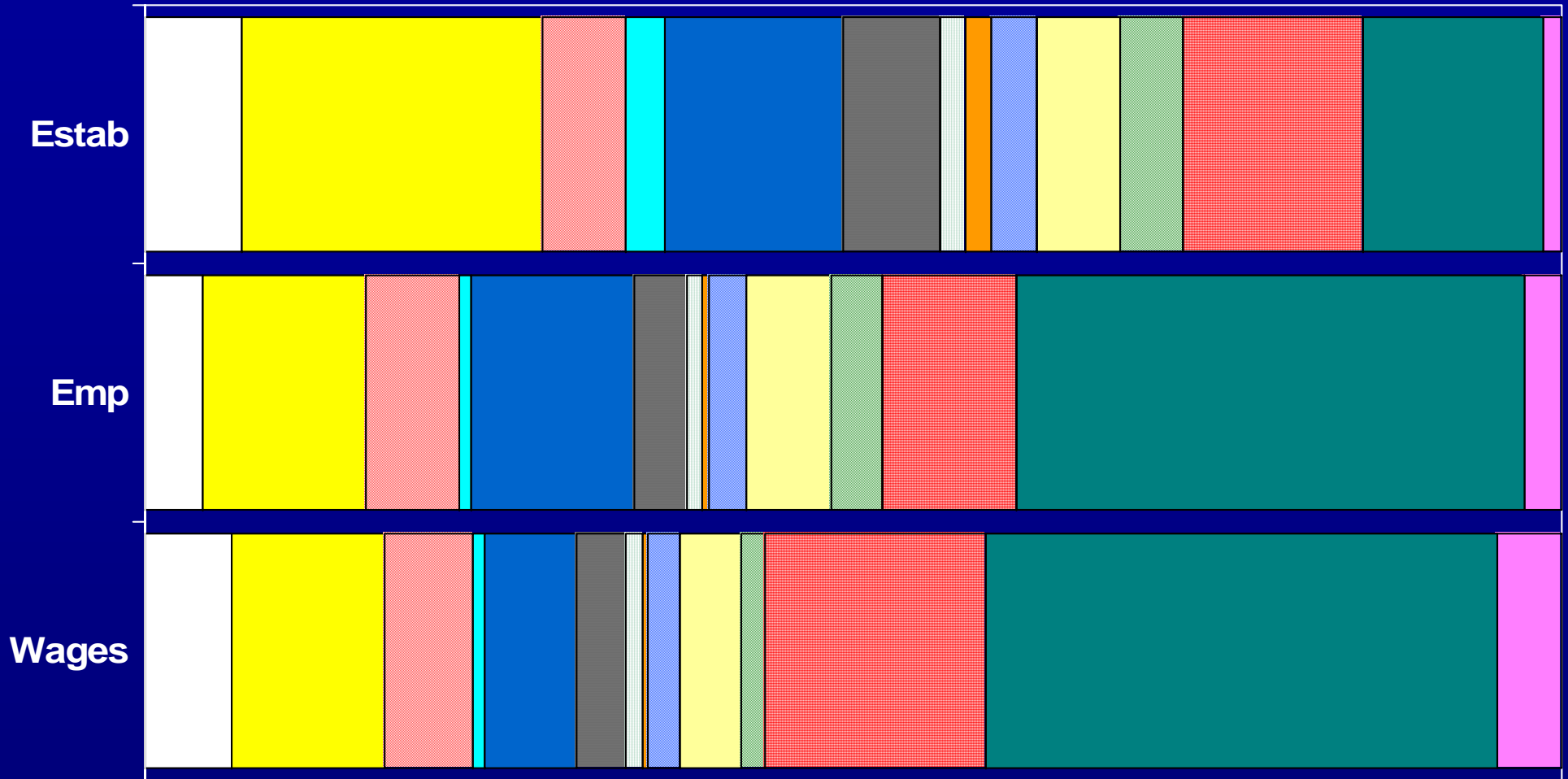

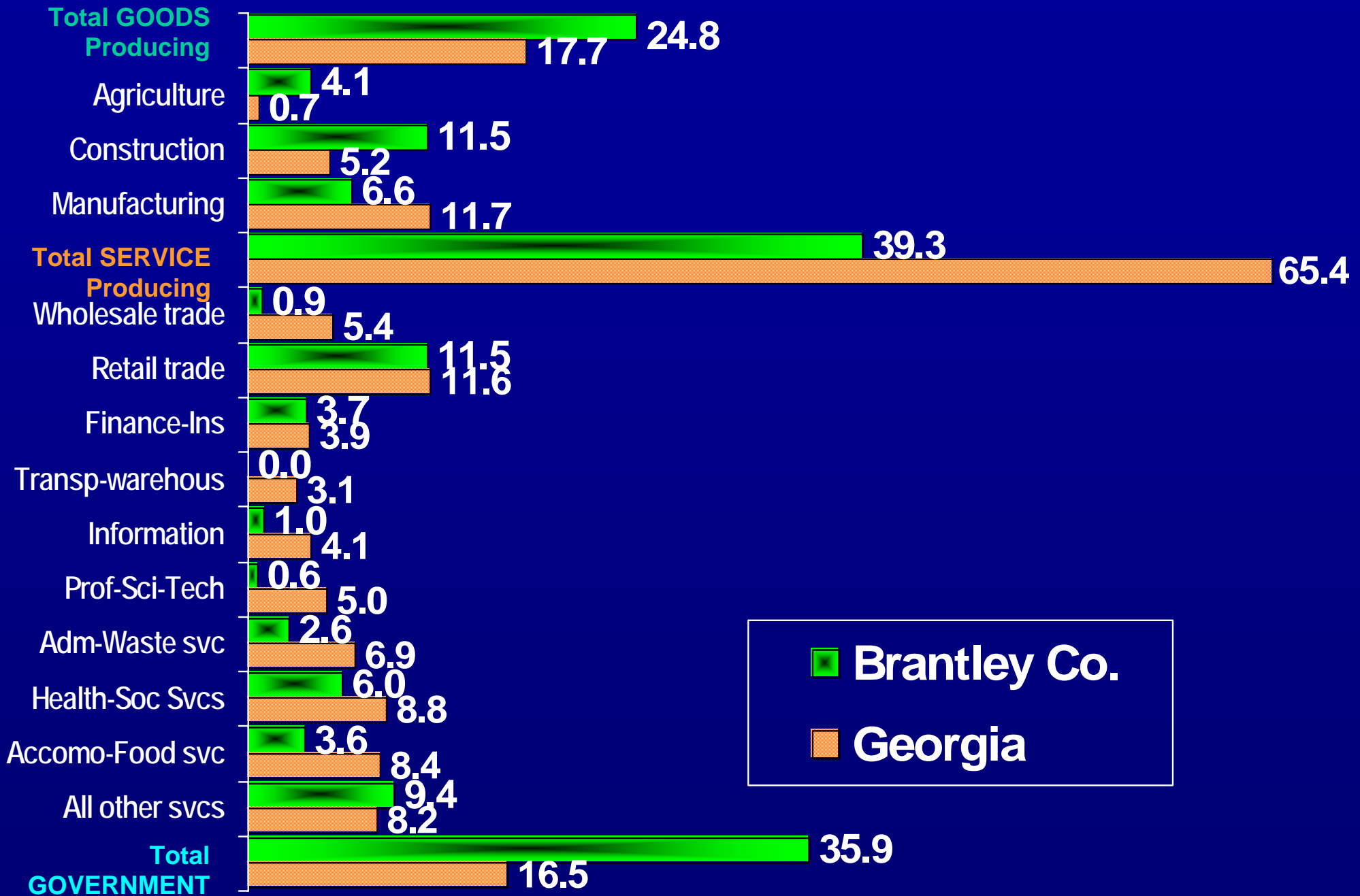

Business Establishments, Employment and Wages Brantley County 2004 Annual Averages, % of Total



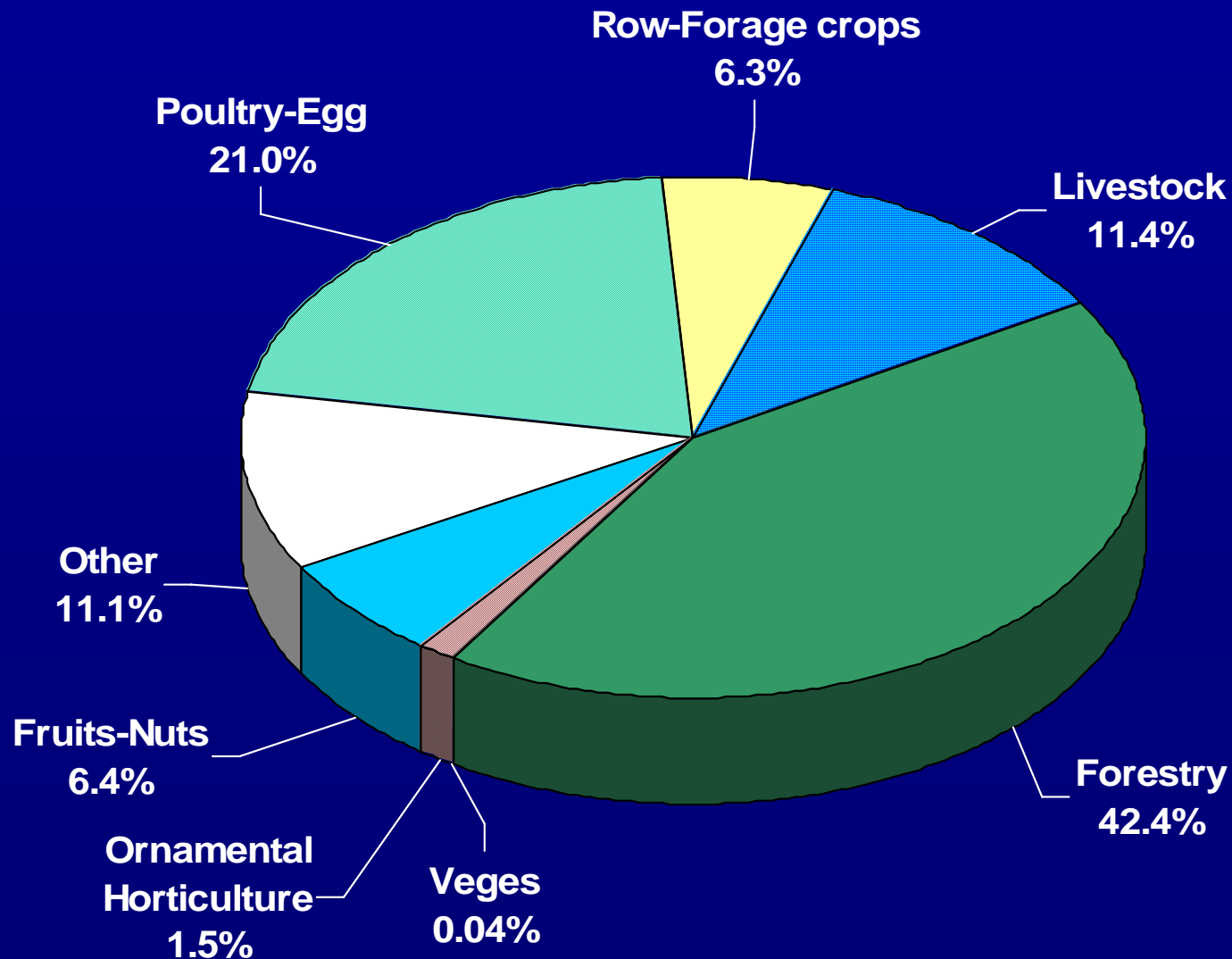
Employment Comparisons by Industry: 2004

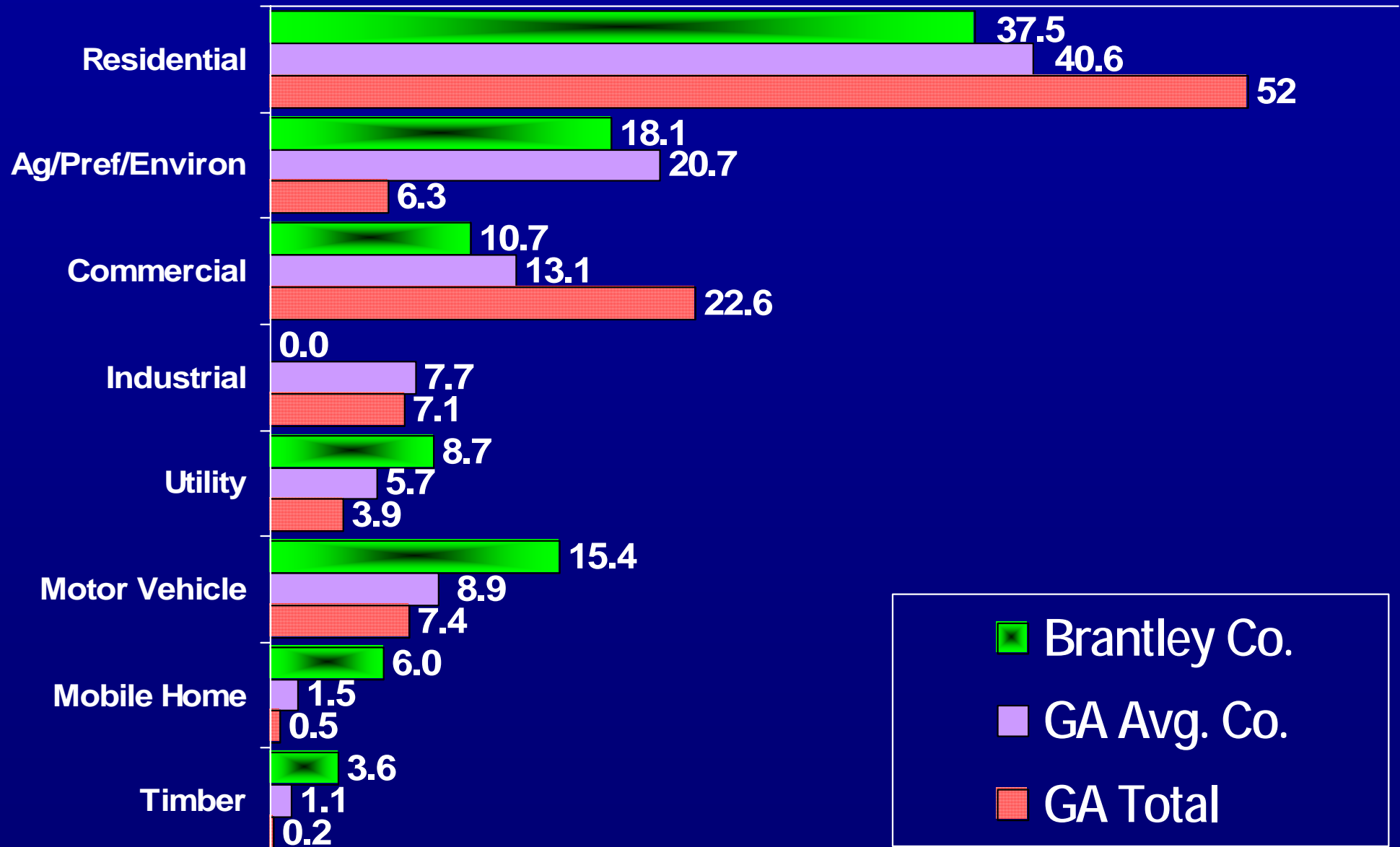
Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group: 2005

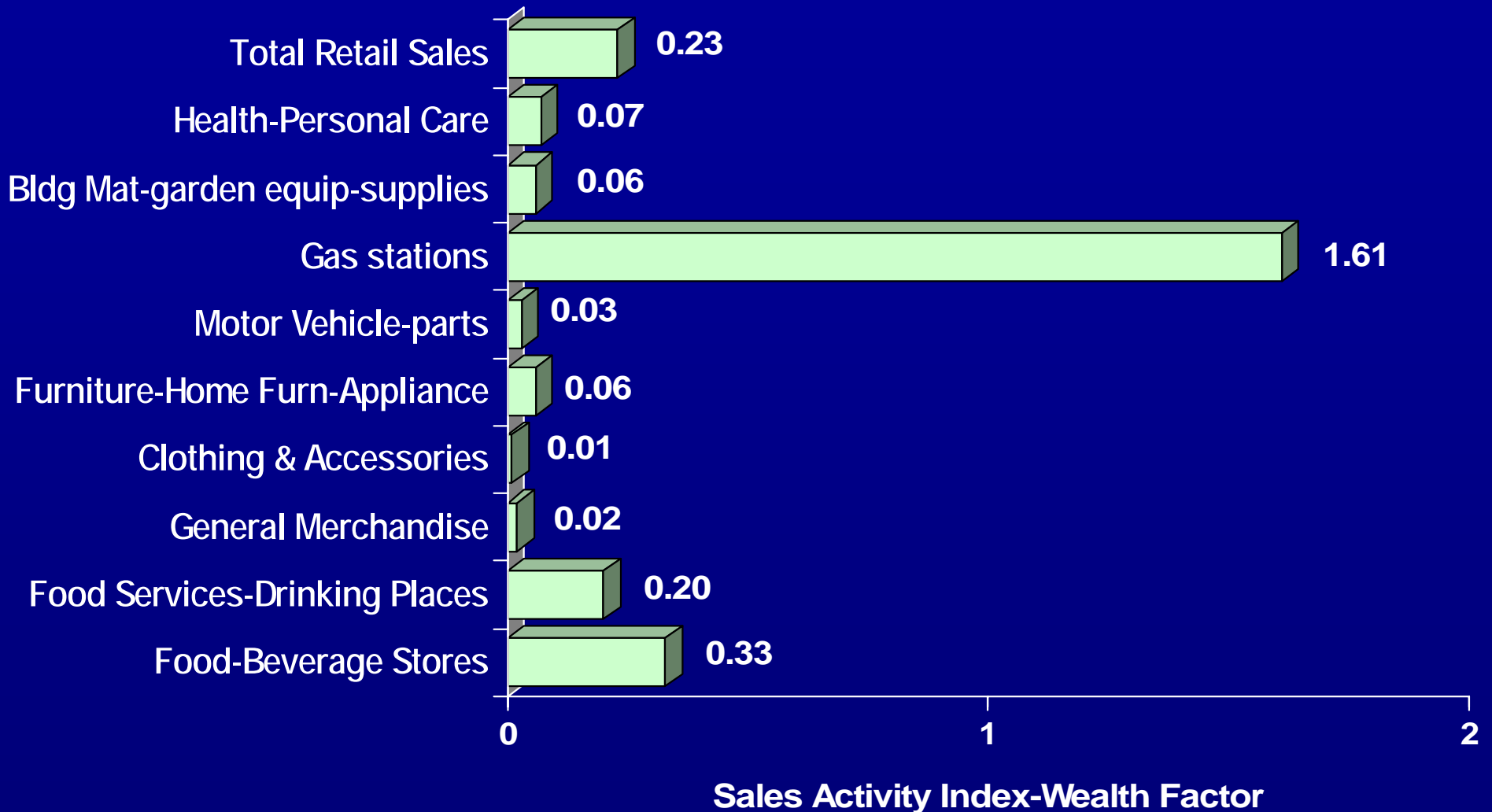

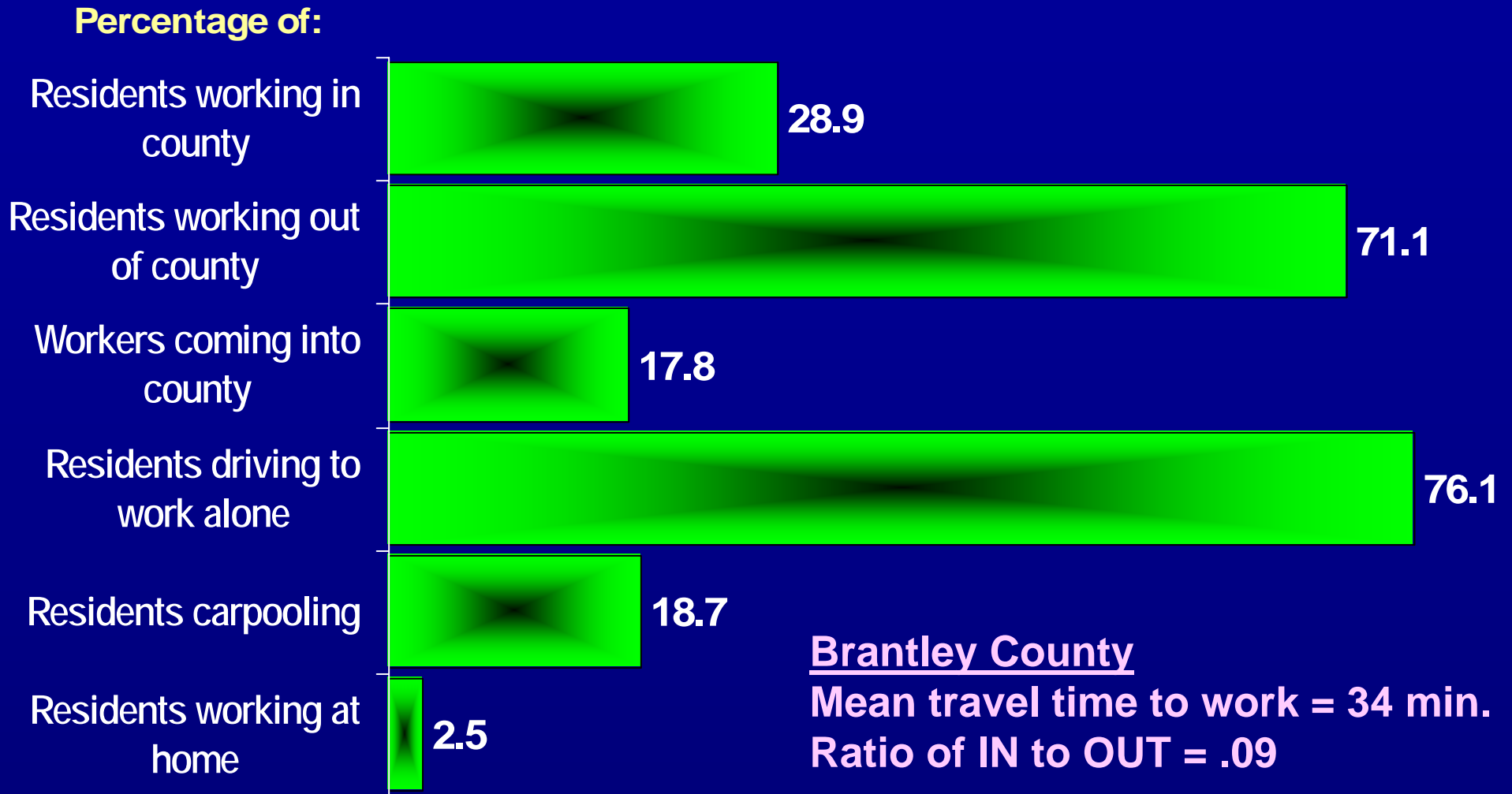
Retail Sales Analysis: 2004

Brantley Co. Total Retail Sales = \$33,444,000
