

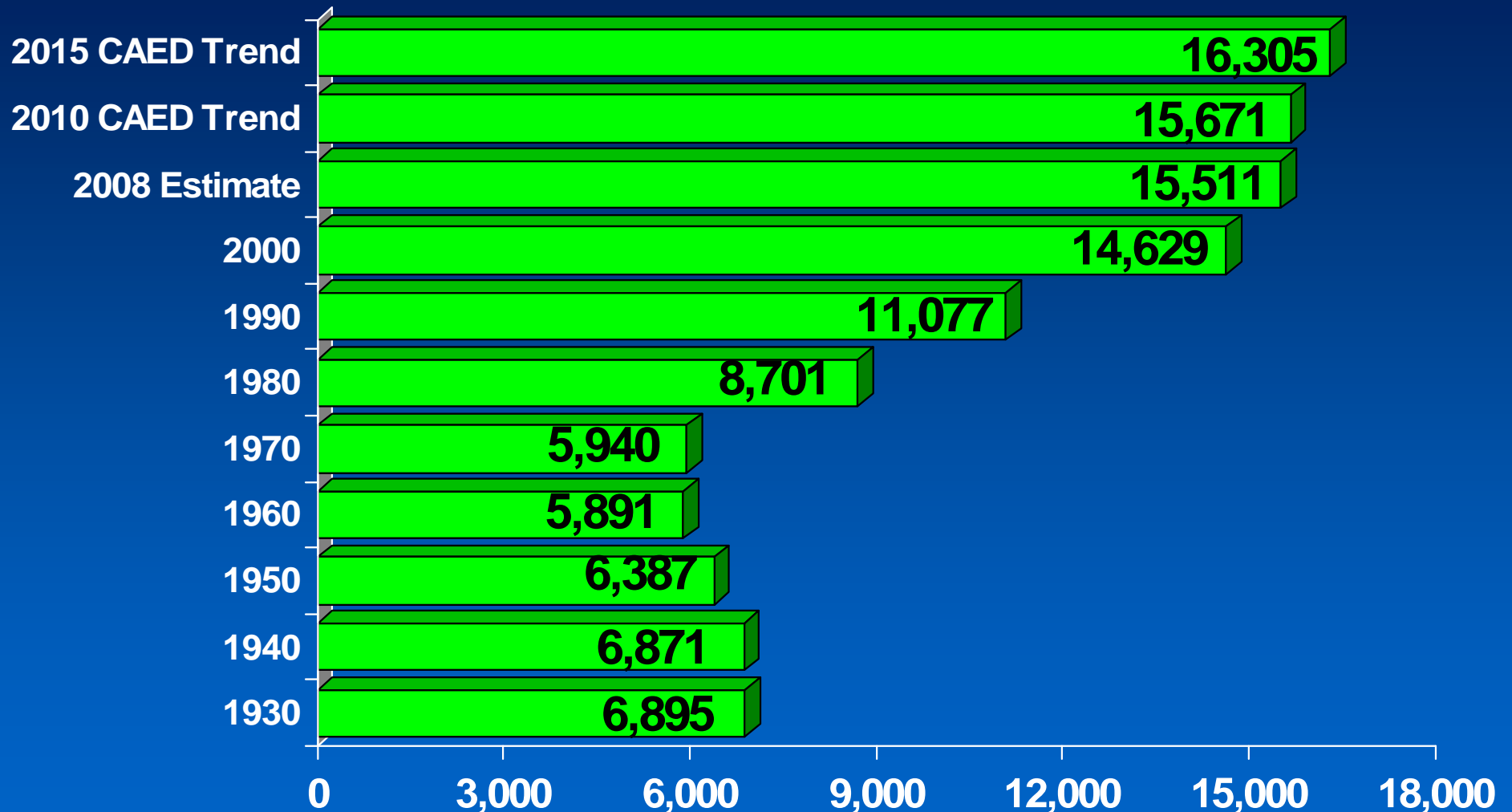

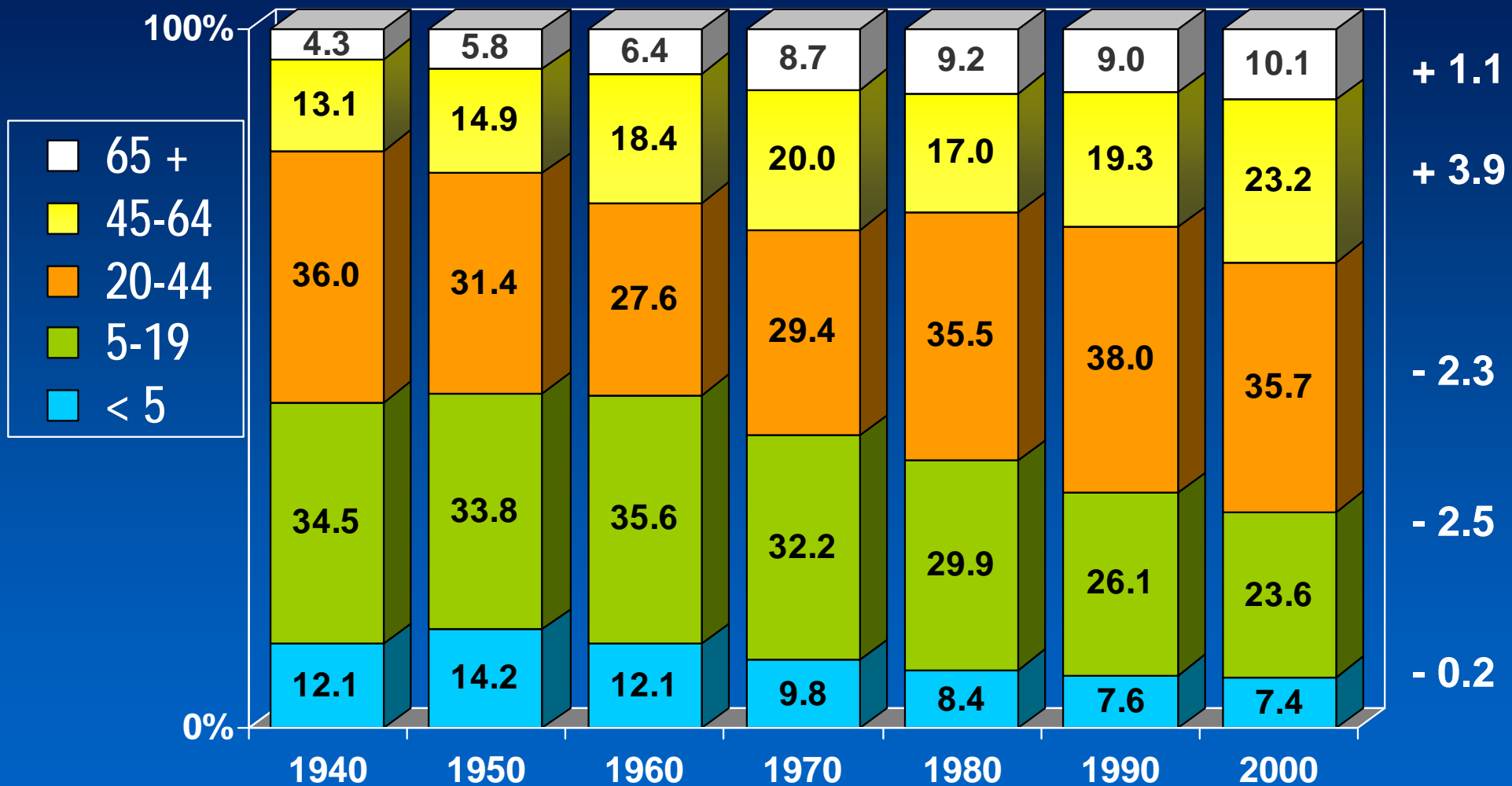
# Total Population Brantley County

2008 Estimated Median Age

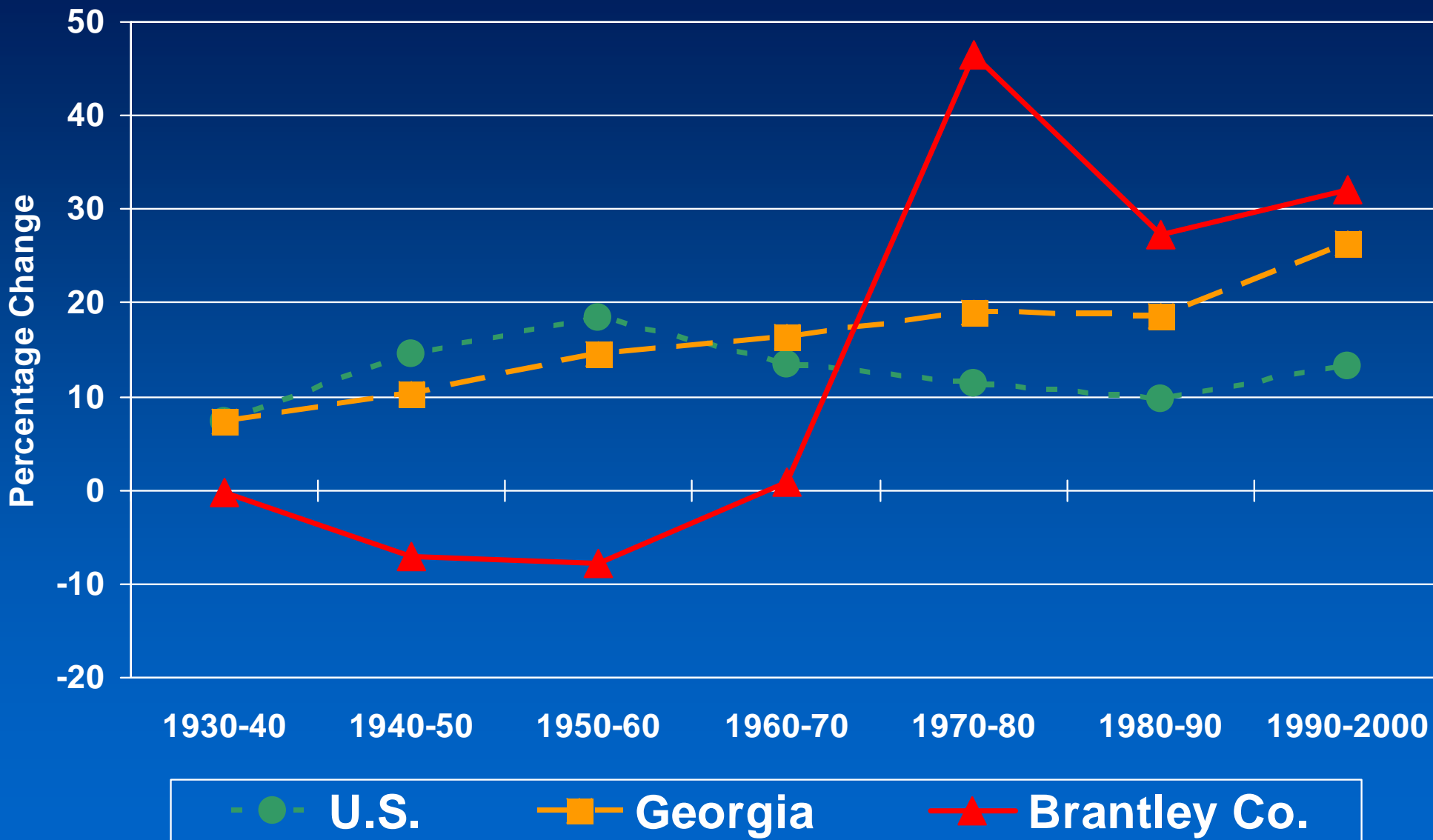

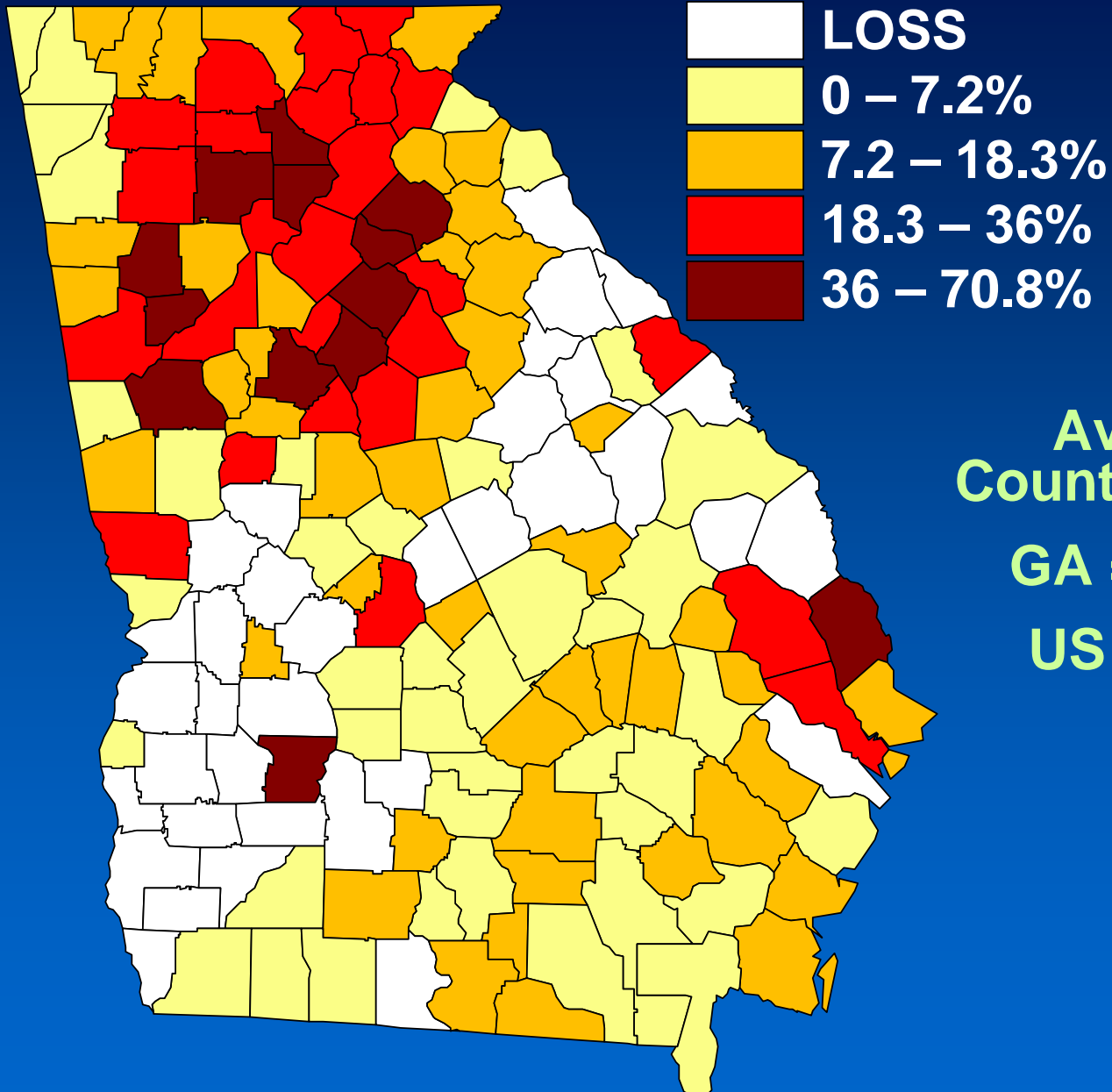

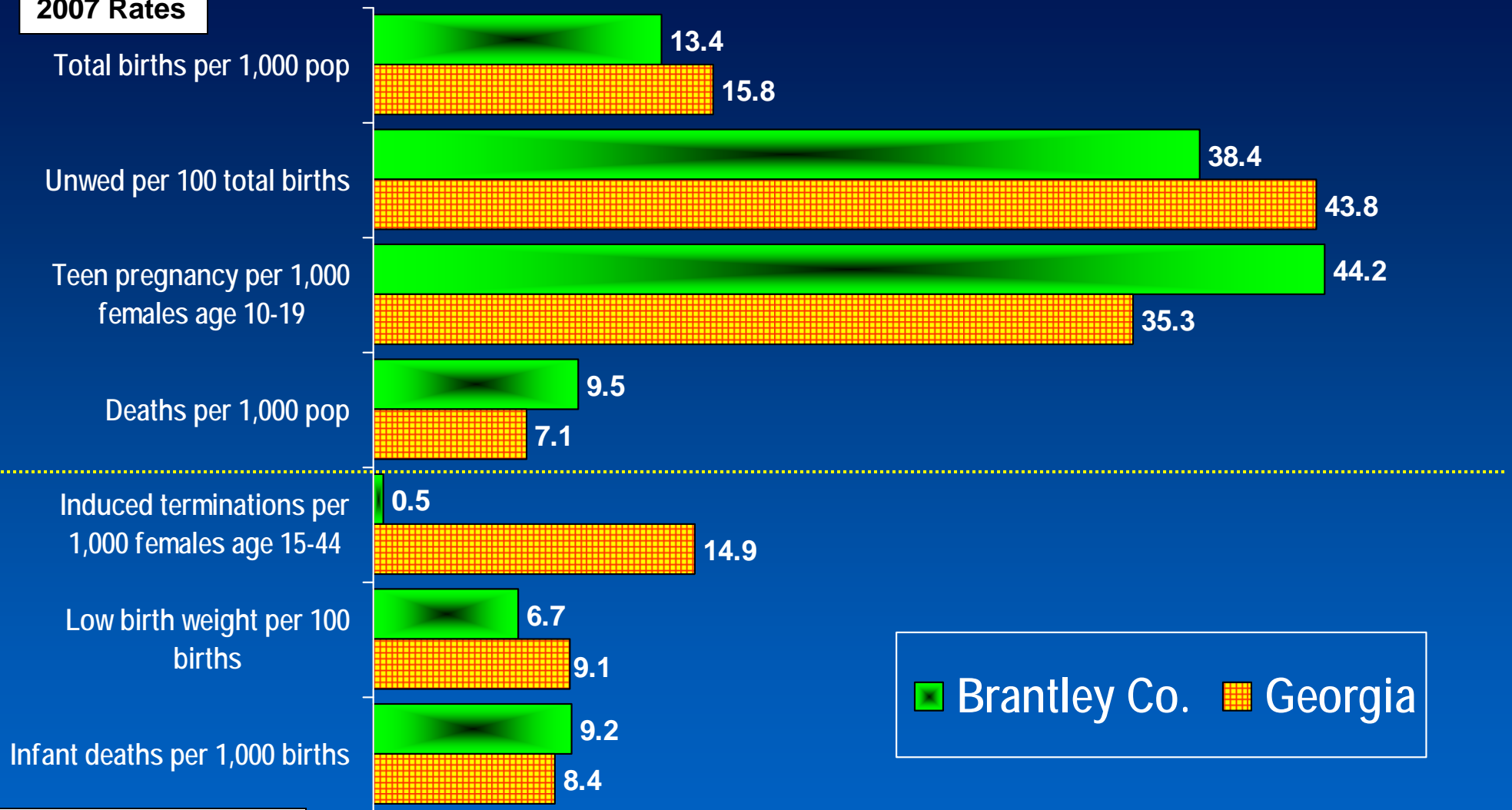

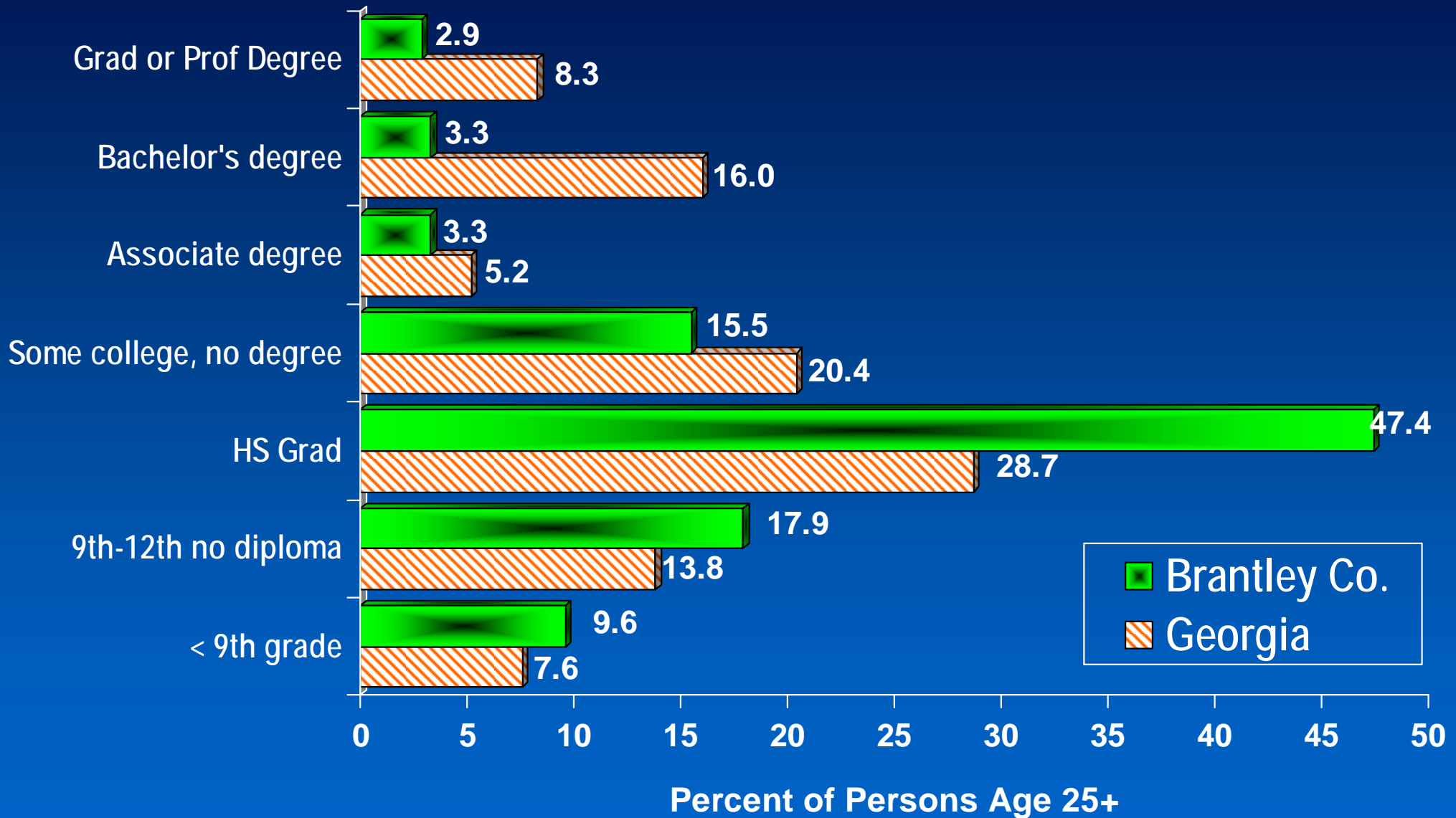

# Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2000



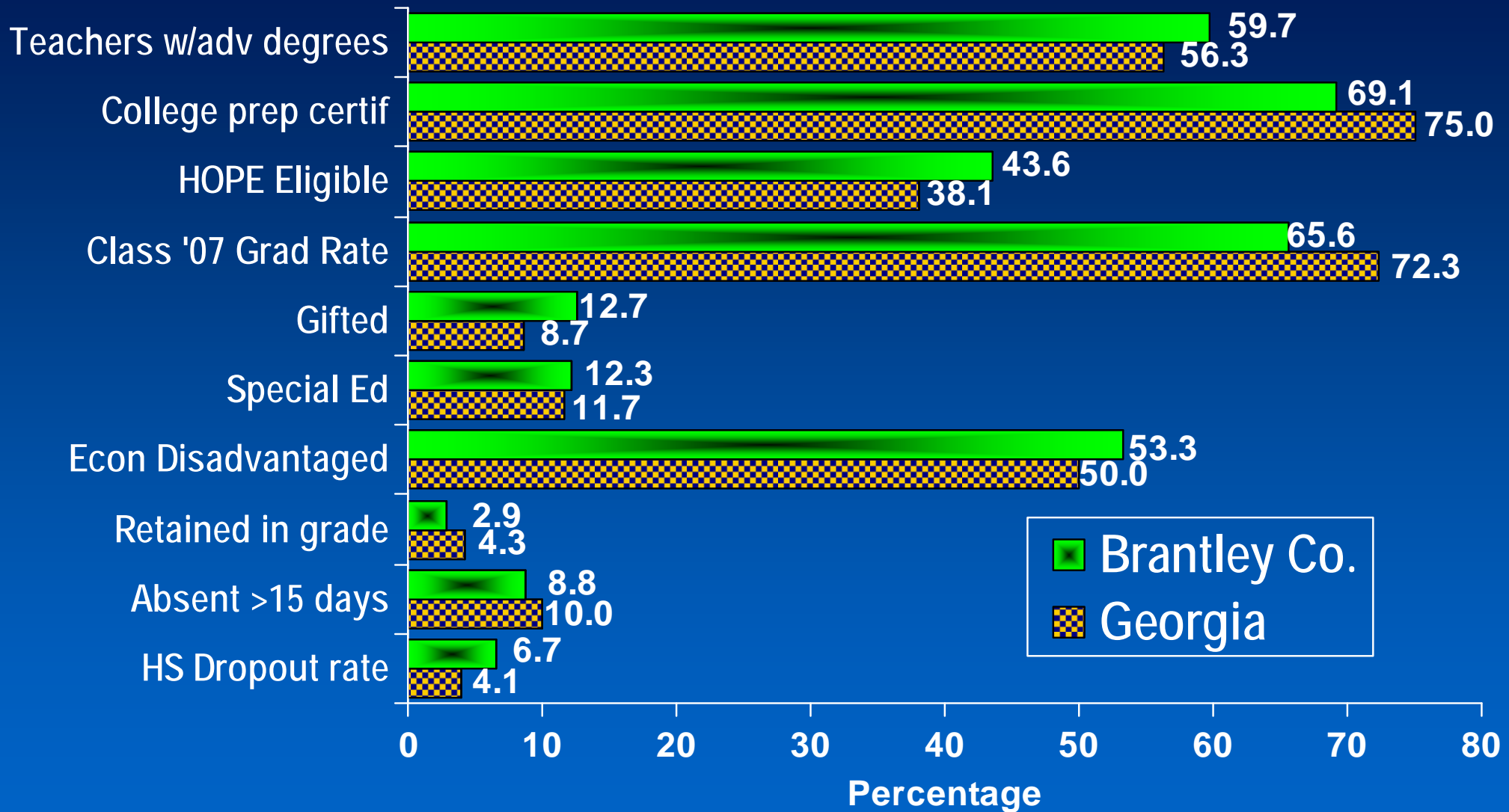

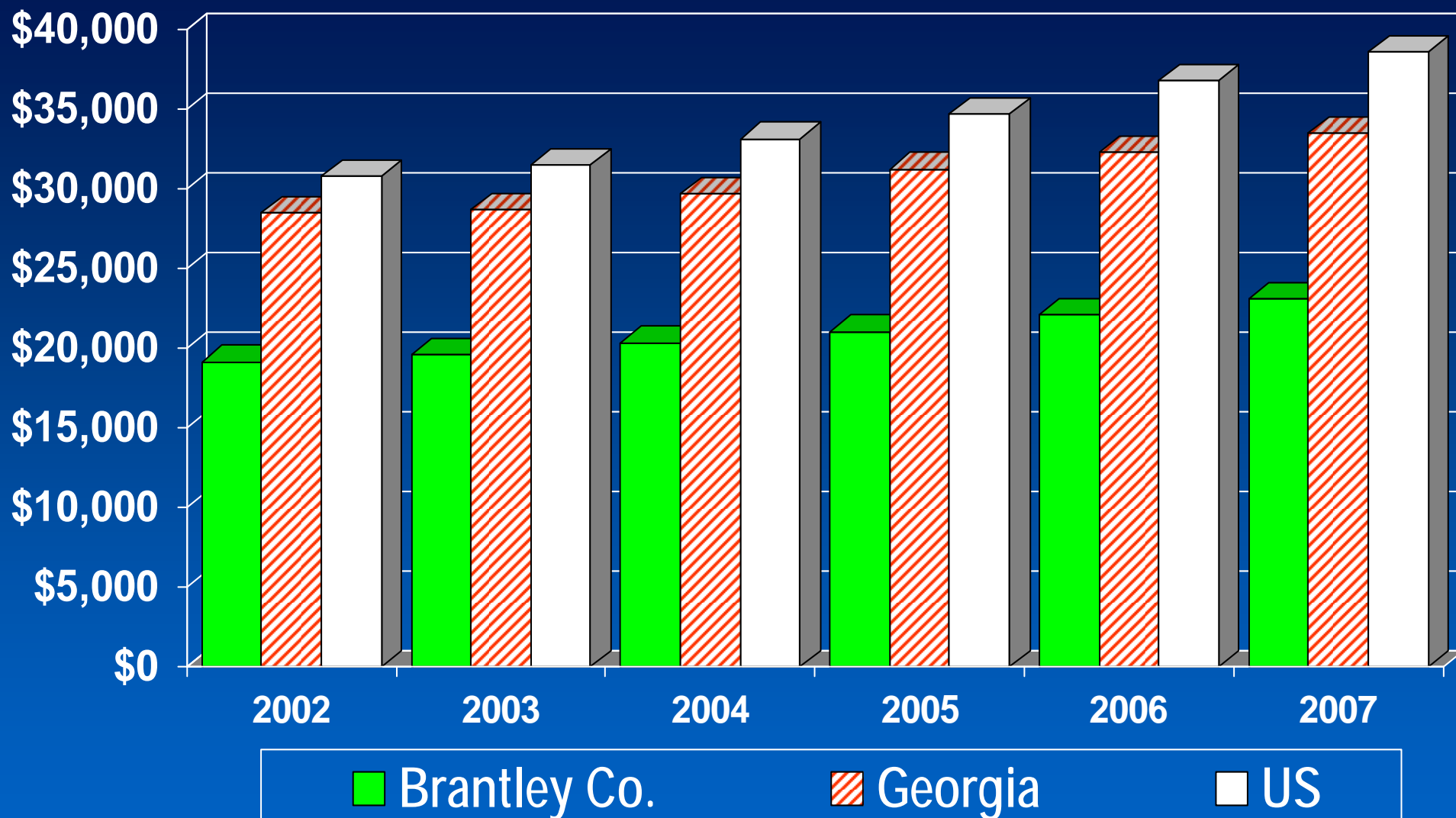

# Per Capita Income: 2002-2007

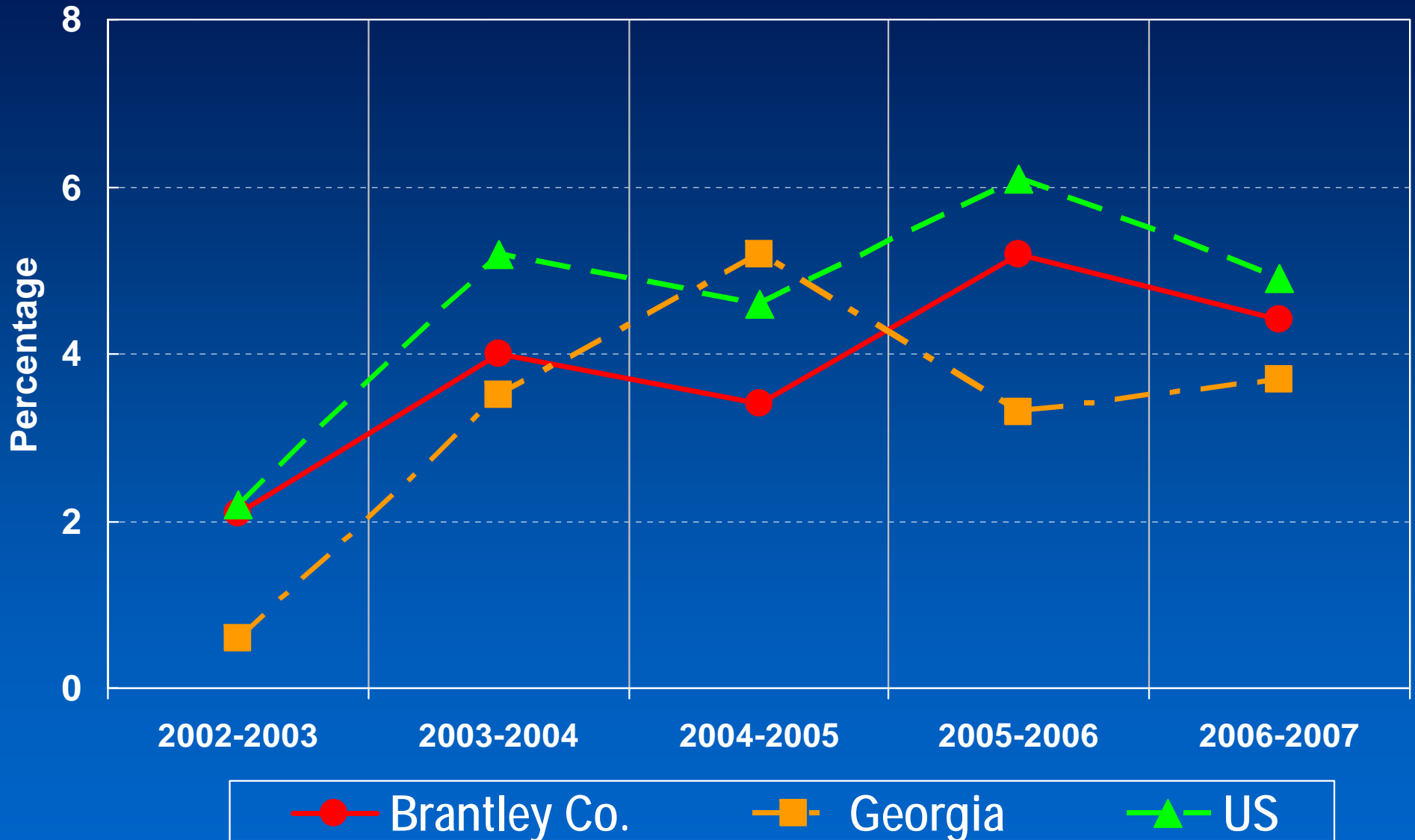

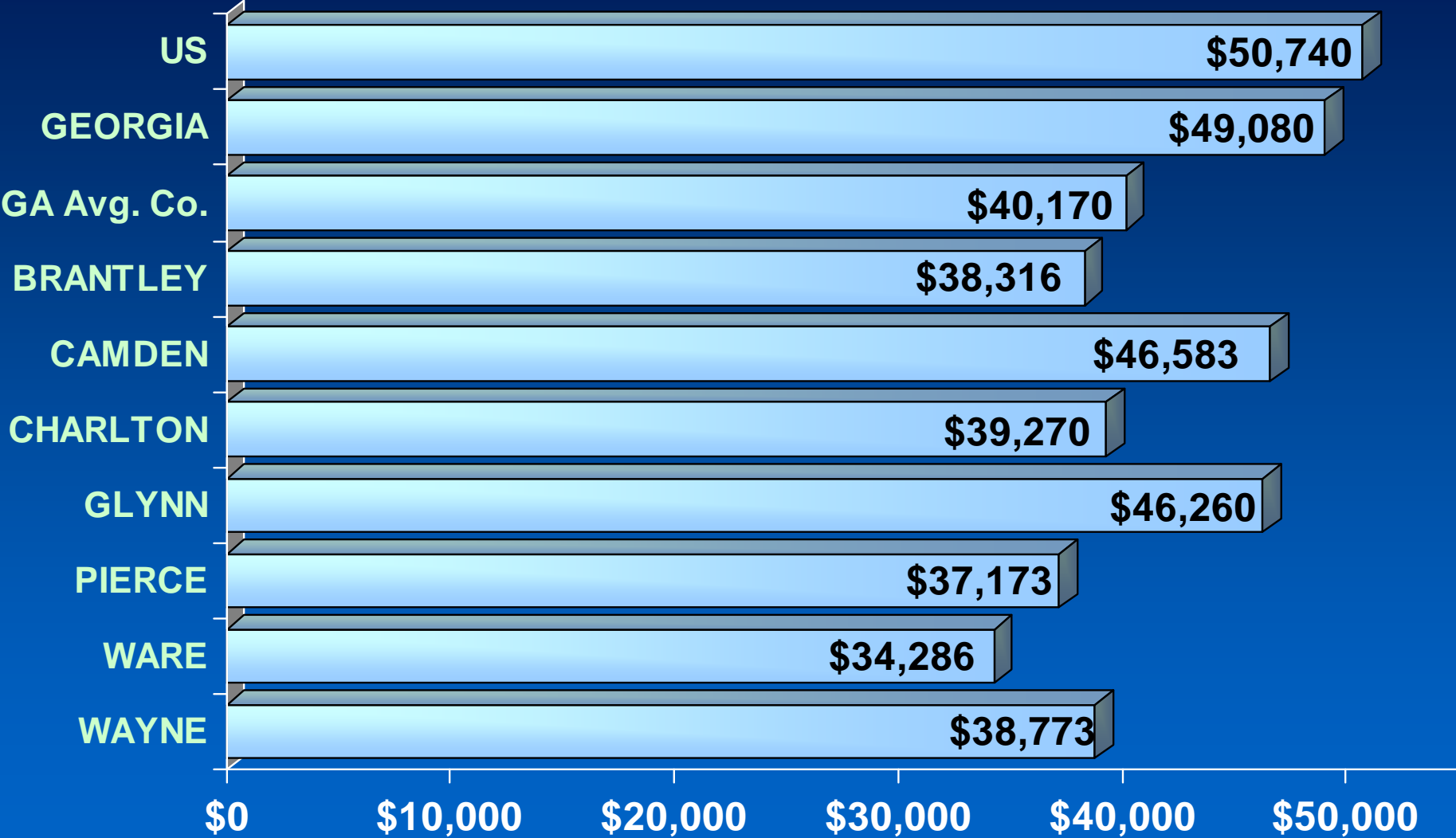

# Median Household Income

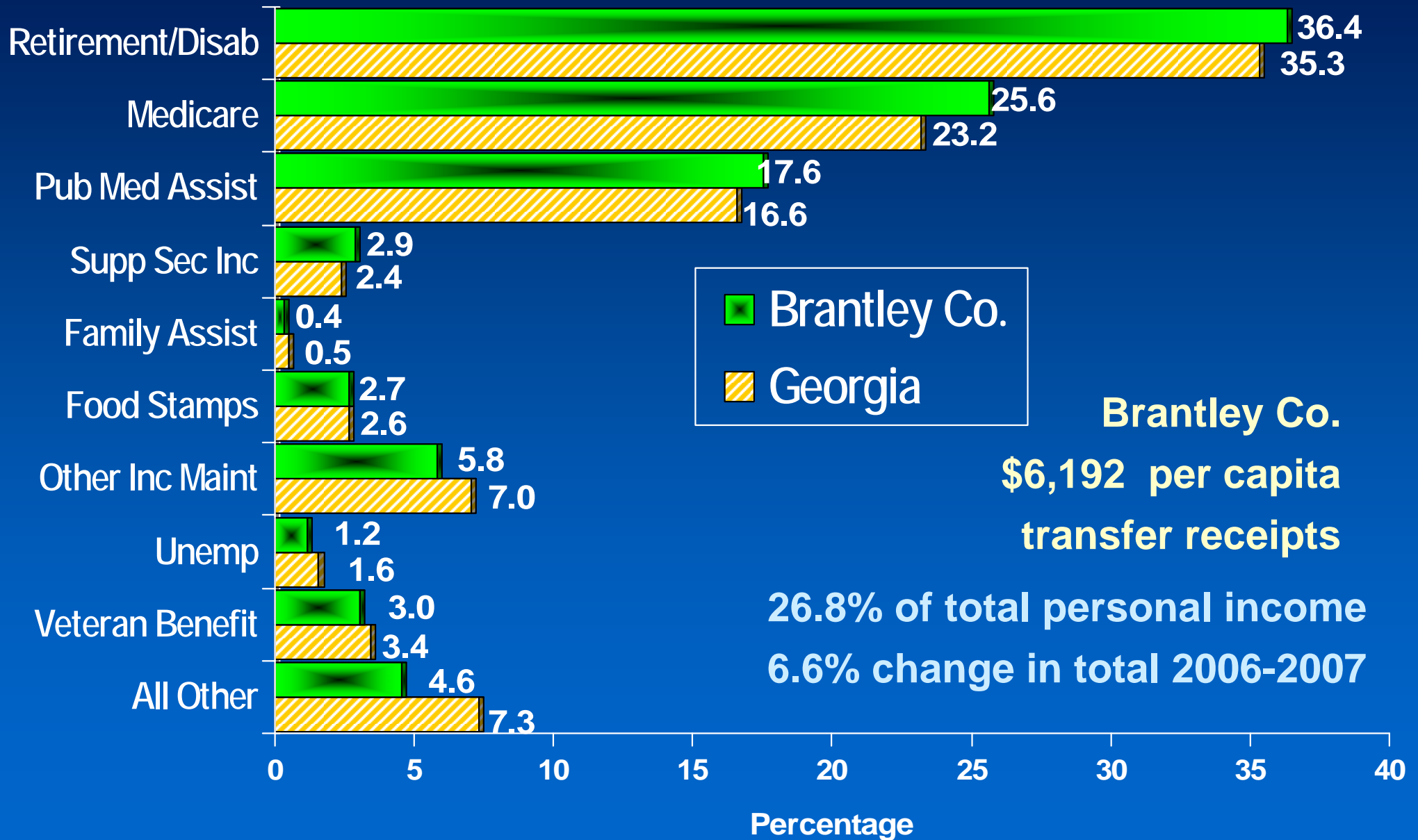
## 2007 Model-Based Estimates

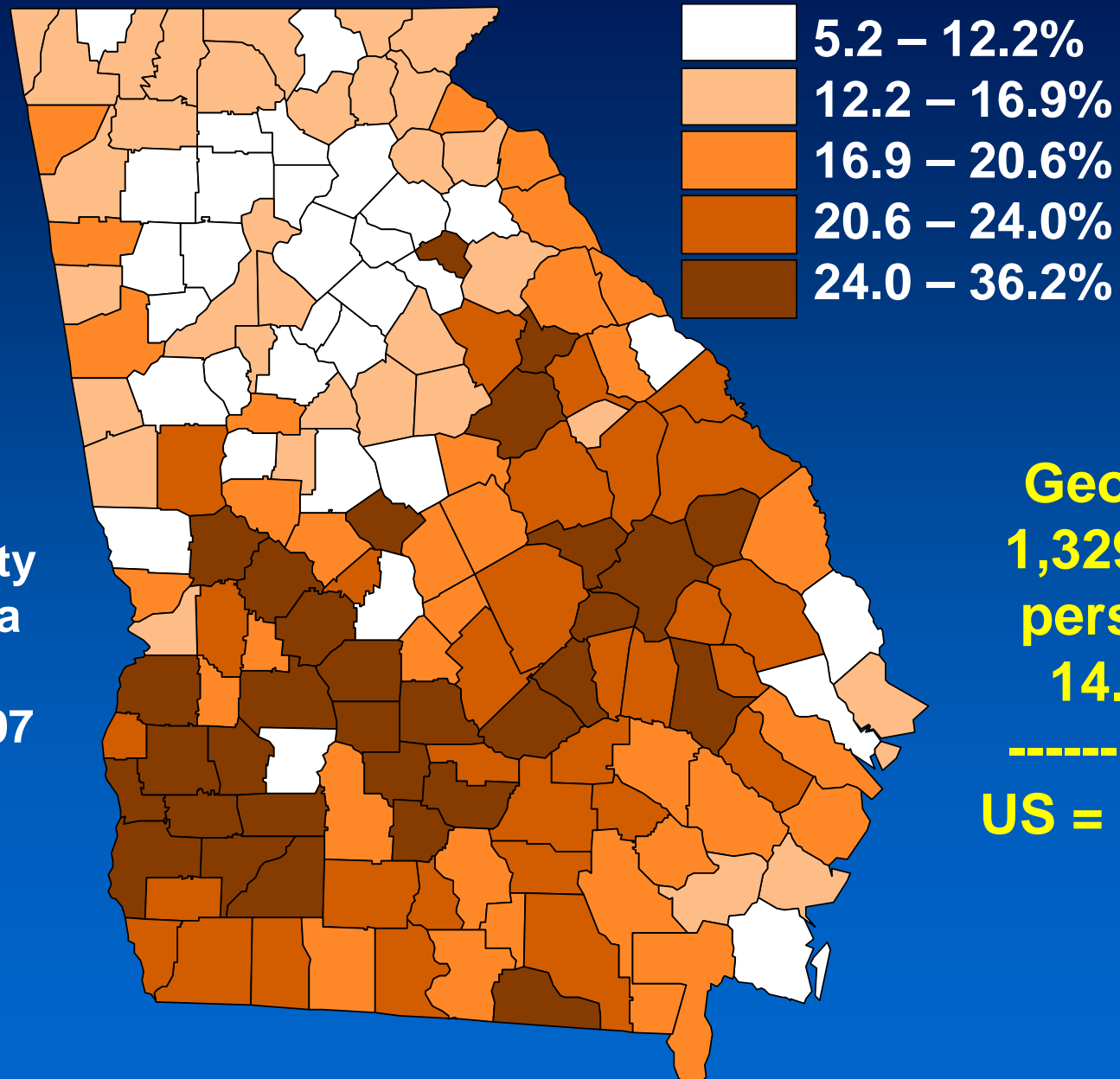

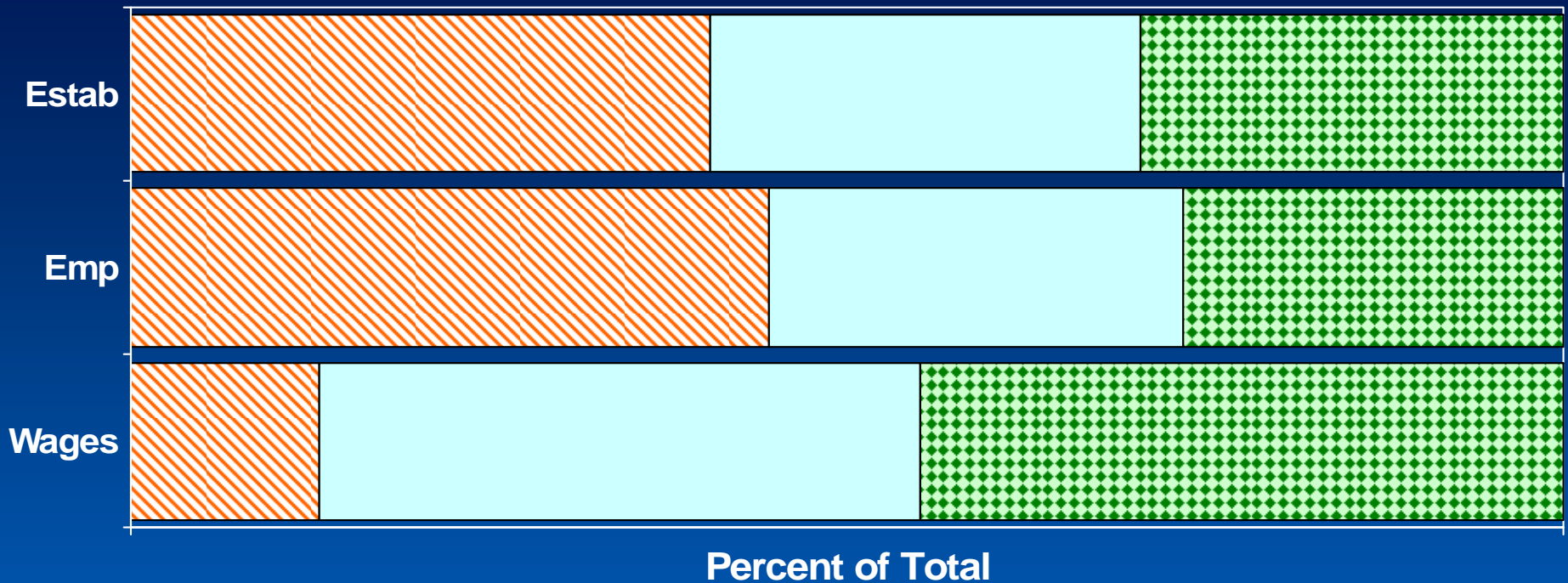

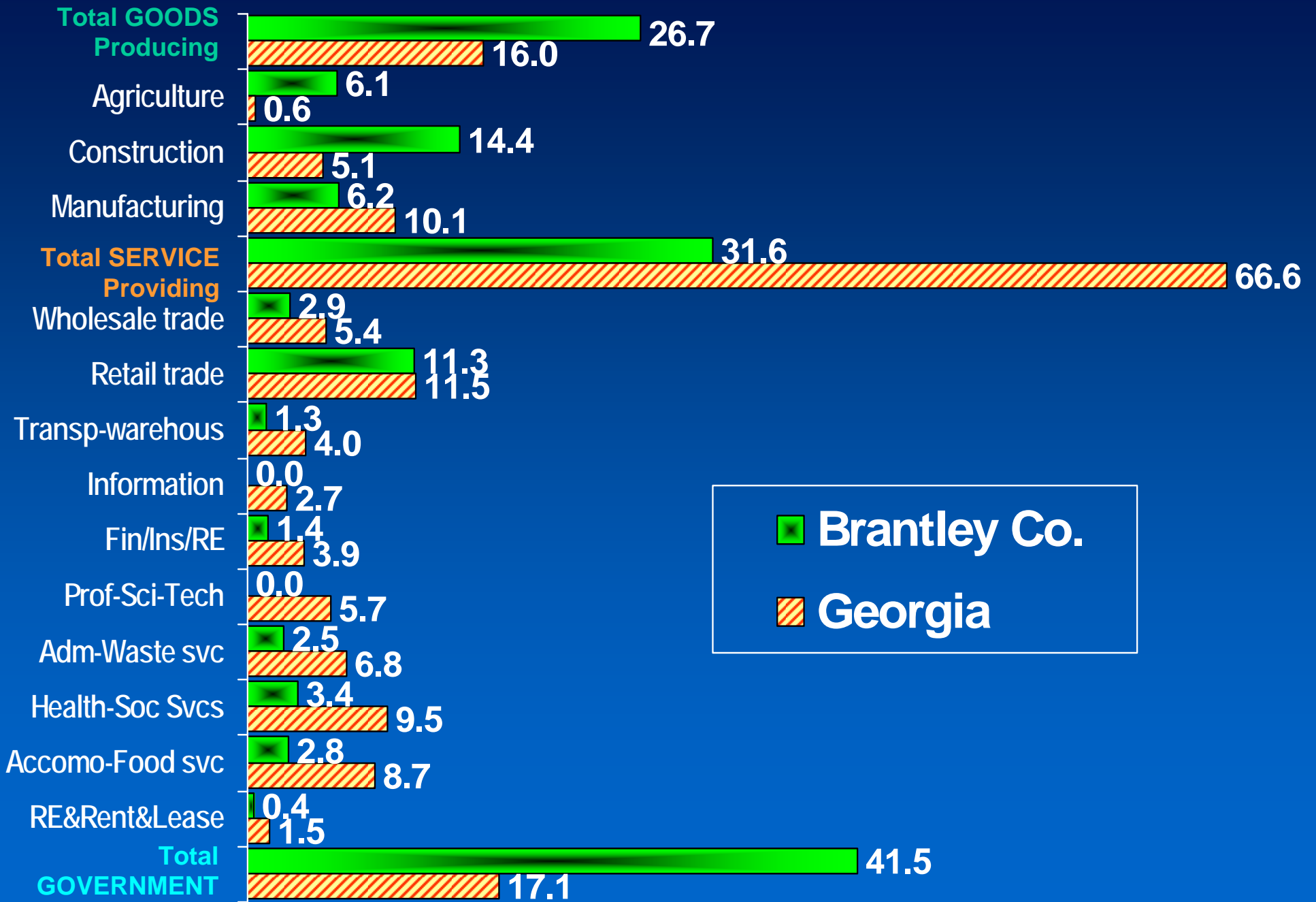

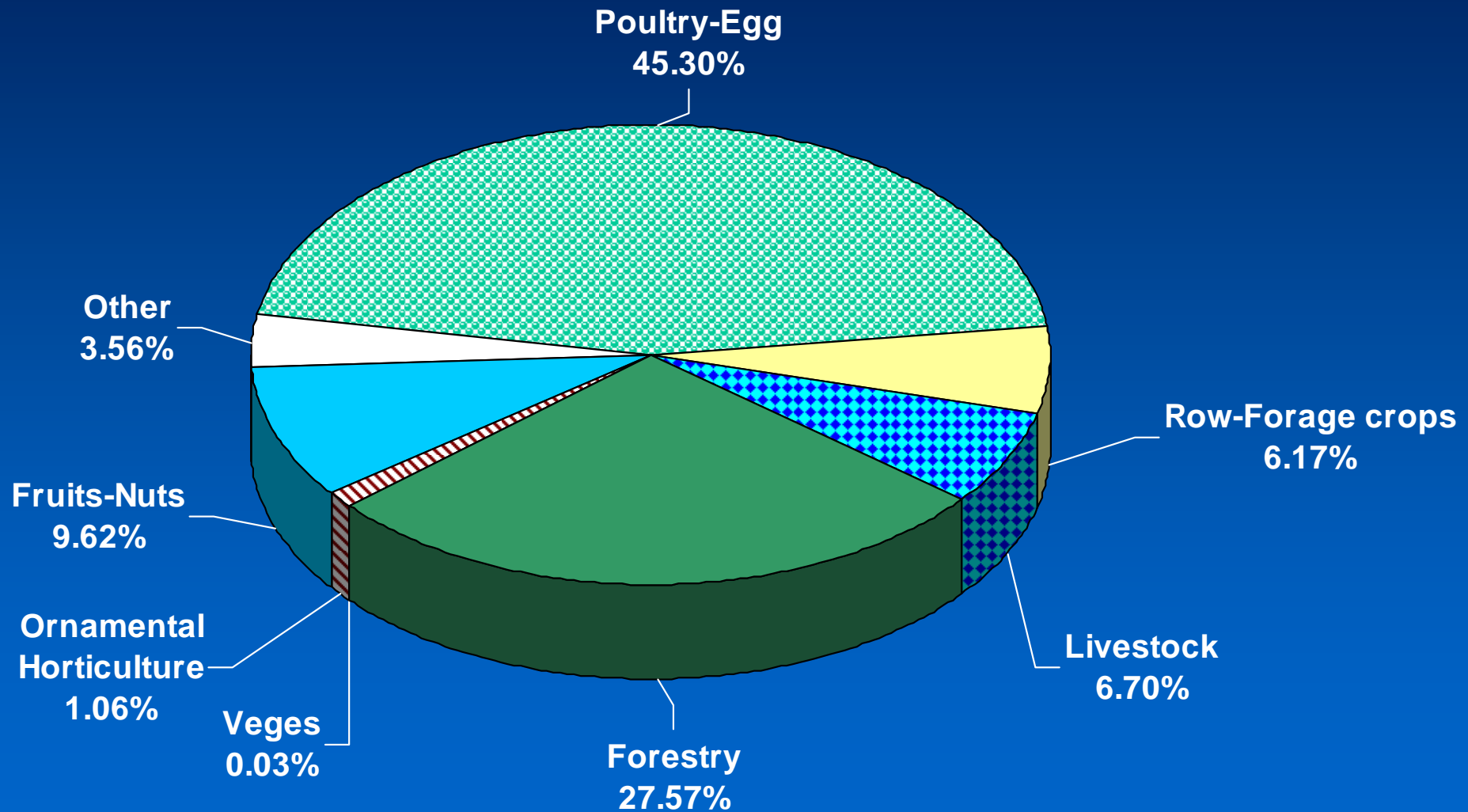
# Selected Employment Comparisons by Industry: 2008

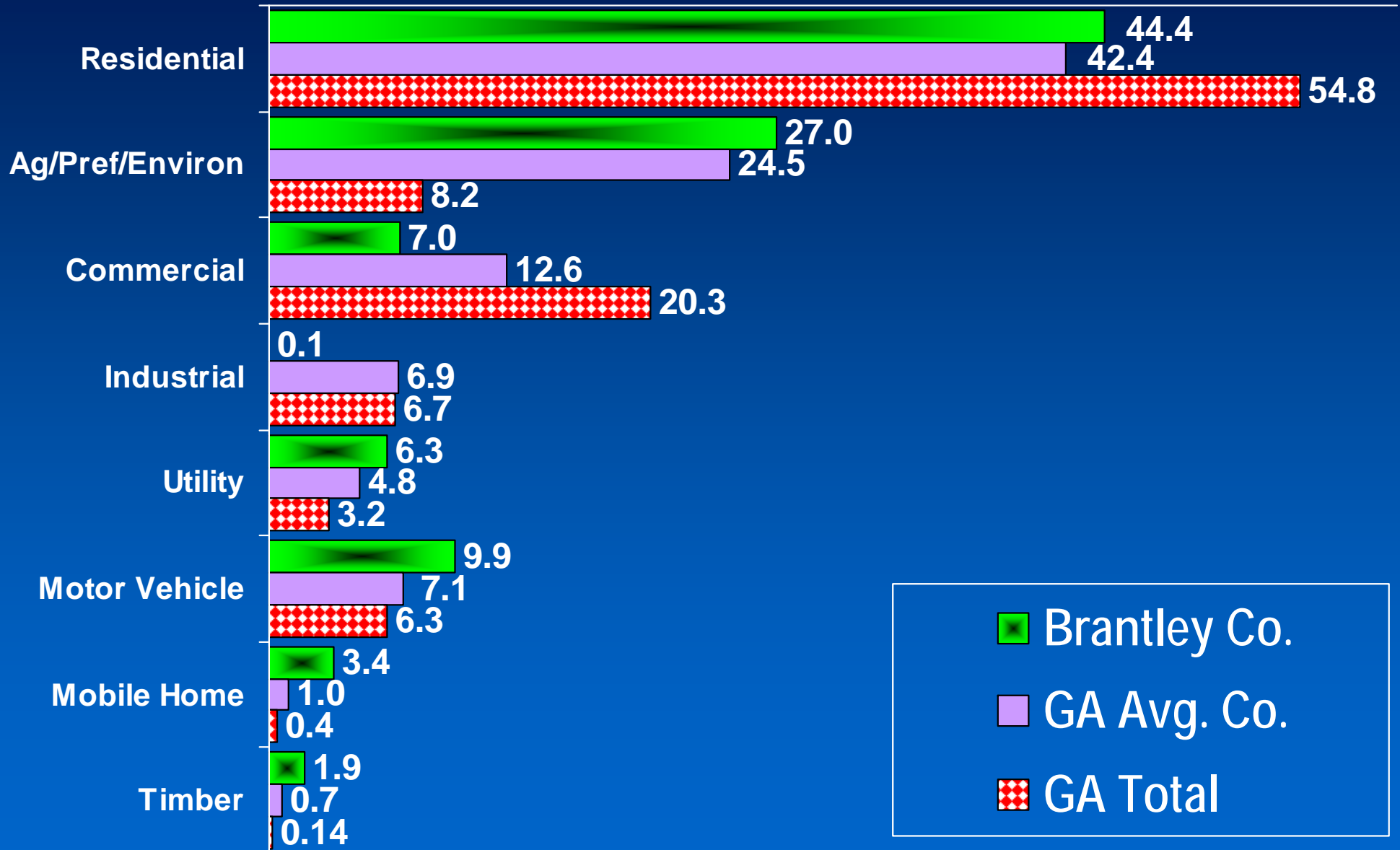
# Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group: 2008

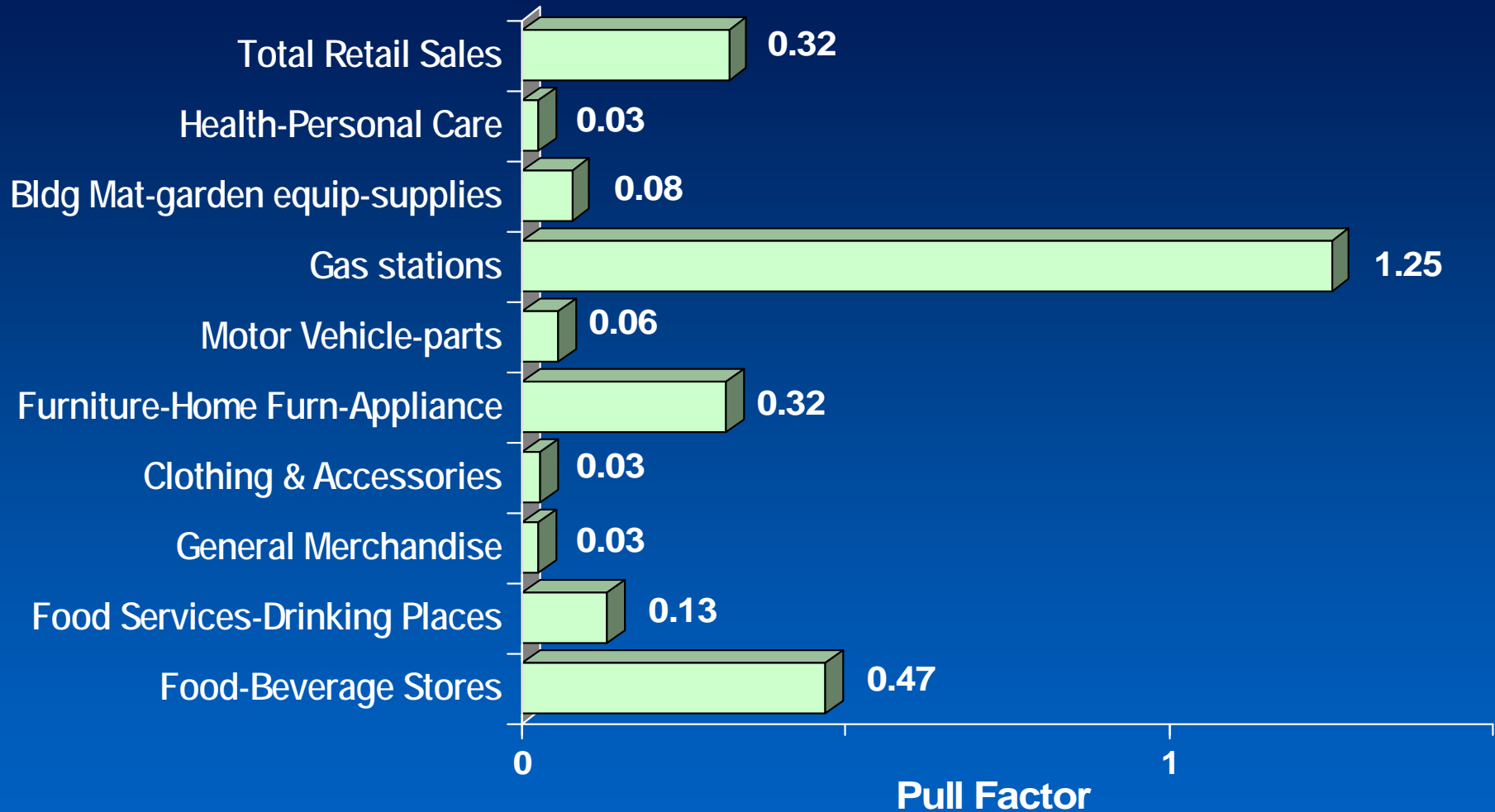

# Retail Sales Analysis: 2008

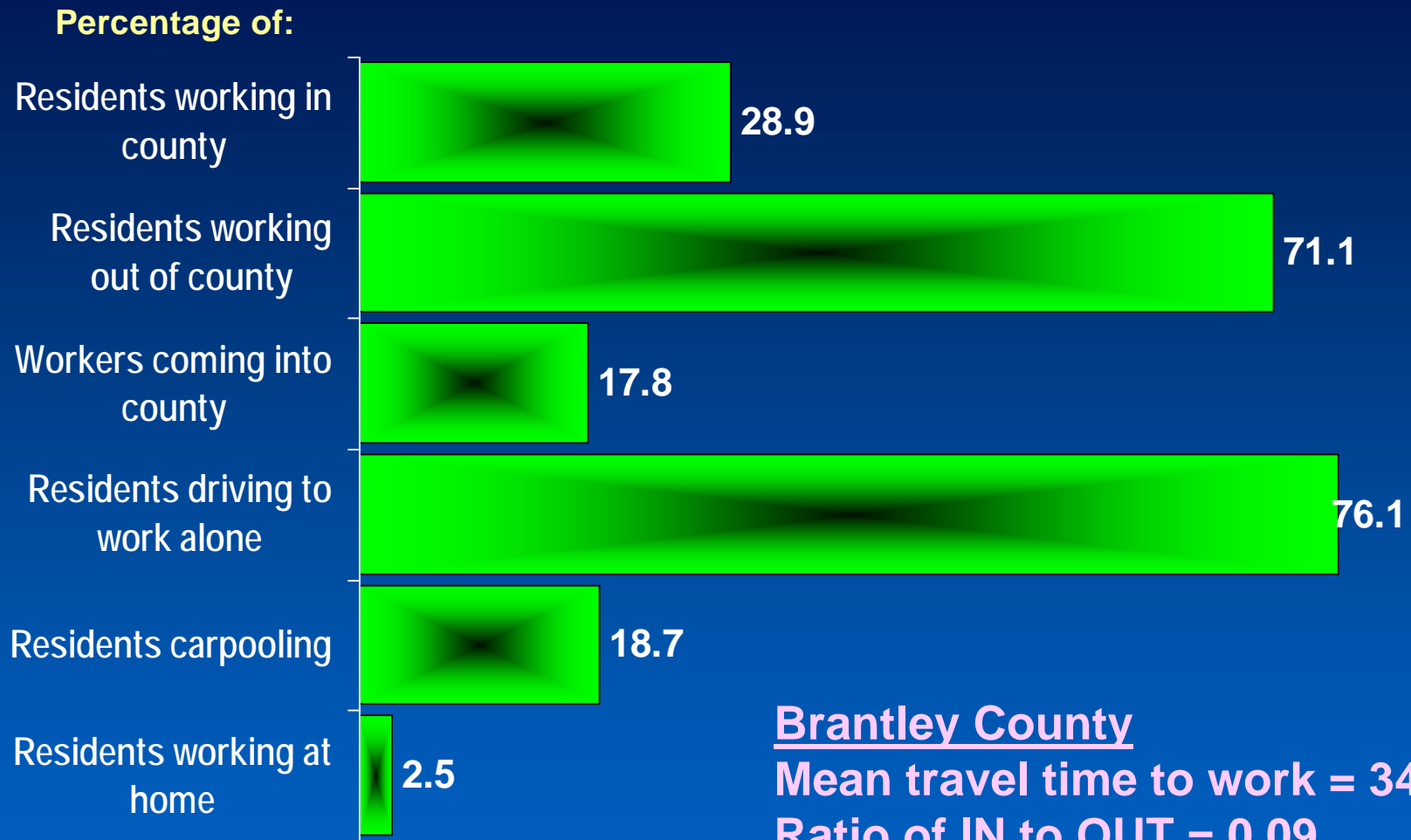
## Brantley Co. Total Retail Sales = \$60,562,000

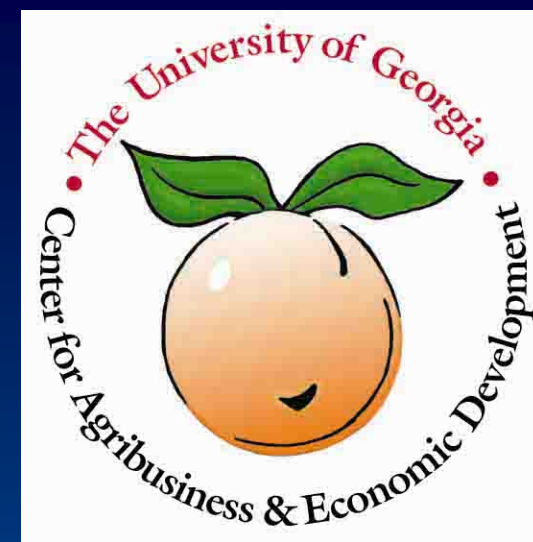
