


Total Population Randolph County

2007 Estimated Median Age



Population Change: 1930-2000





Population Change: 2000-2007




Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2000





Per Capita Income: 2001-2006 Percentage Change













Employment Comparisons by Industry: 2007








Retail Sales Analysis: 2007 Randolph Co. Total Retail Sales = \$46,038,000
