


Total Population Harris County










Highest Level of Educational Attainment: 2000




Per Capita Income: 2002-2007







Persons Living Below the Poverty Level 2008 Model-Based Estimates




Weighted average poverty threshold for a family household of 4 persons in 2008 = \$22,025



Selected Employment Comparisons by Industry: 2008





Retail Sales Analysis: 2008 Harris Co. Total Retail Sales = \$65,163,000




A "pull factor" of 1.0 means that the county's sales are what would be expected based upon the number of residents and their relative wealth.
