



2008 Estimated Median Age



Population Change: 1930-2000



















Persons Living Below the Poverty Level 2008 Model-Based Estimates




Weighted average poverty threshold for a family household of 4 persons in 2008 = \$22,025

Business Establishments, Employment and Wages Pike Co. 2008 Annual Averages, % of Total




Selected Employment Comparisons by Industry: 2008






